3 threatening to fail. And they immediately approved my  
4 recommendation to repair the tree.

5           Q. Okay. Can you give me another example?

7 were times when I pointed out limbs overhanging cabins  
8 that they usually approved without argument.

9           Q. Can you give me examples of recommendations  
10 that they would argue about? By they, I mean the  
11 camp.

12          A. Yeah, I was -- at every visit I would always  
13 discuss fire safety, and they always resisted the  
14 thinning projects that I talked about.

15          Q. Okay. Can you give me another example?

16          A. No.

17          Q. Now, you said you know who Ken Kramarz is,  
18 correct?

19          A. Yes.

20          Q. How many times would you estimate that you have  
21 met him?

22          A. Ten.

23          Q. And how many times would you estimate that you  
24 received push-back or argument from the camp in  
25 implementing any of the recommendations or work that you
