Good afternoon from Midway Nursing Home

This a COVID-19 update.

The COVID transmission rate in Queens remains high. Per CDC recommendations and guidance, we have been testing our staff and residents on an ongoing basis

The results of this weeks' testing revealed 8 COVID + residents. None of these residents have any symptoms. All are on isolation as required. Testing of staff & residents per our protocols will continue to be conducted. We have consulted with the NYS Dept of Health and are following all guidance and recommendations.

Over the past few weeks, a number of visitors have tested positive as well. While all are asymptomatic, it is apparent that COVID remains active not only in our community and county but in almost every county in NYS and the numbers are increasing as new variant strains emerge.

It is especially important to remain vigilant about wearing a mask, practicing good hand hygiene and staying up to date on vaccines and boosters. If you have not done so already, consider getting vaccinated and if eligible, get a booster.

Let's all do everything we can to stop the spread of COVID 19 not only here at Midway but at home and in our community.
