

SUNDAY YOUTH LEAGUE 2019 Spring Season
PIN TWIST FAMILY ENTERTAINMENT
CENTER
SEGUIN, TEXAS

The Sunday Youth League will bowl on Sunday at 3 pm at Pin Twist Family Entertainment Center. The league will have a scheduled starting date of 12/16/18 and a scheduled ending date of 5/12/18 and will participate for a total of 20 weeks.

Rule 1. The league shall be managed by the League President/Youth Supervisor, the League Secretary/Youth Official, and the Team Captains.

League President/Youth Supervisor- John Harborth

Rule 2. Membership in the league is open to males and females from age 6 to age 19 as of August 1 of the current bowling season.

Rule 3. Each league member will pay \$ 10 at each league session to cover the cost of bowling and shoes, if needed.

Rule 4. Bowlers will establish their league average in their first league session, after completing 3 games. A bowler using a two-hand delivery will establish an average with two hands. When, and if, the bowler changes to a one-hand delivery, they must establish an average using that hand. This average will be established after 3 games have been completed.

Rule 5. The league will determine wins and losses on a (handicap/scratch) basis. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between a bowler's average and a scratch figure of 200. (Refer to USBC Rule 100g, Item 1.)

Rule 6. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between a bowler's average and a scratch figure of 200.

Rule 7. No league member may bowl with more than one team for the regularly scheduled games each week.

Rule 8. The minimum legal lineup of 1 players must be present before the completion of the first frame of each game. Regular members and substitutes count toward a legal lineup.

Rule 9. When bowling in a known forfeit situation or scheduled against a non-existent team, the team must bowl at least the team average less 10 pins per player to earn the points.

Rule 10. Absentee and vacancy scores will be allowed when a team has a legal lineup, but less than a full lineup at the start of any game in a series. The absentee score will be the absent member's average minus 10 pins. Handicap will be figured on the average of absent member. Teams having an incomplete roster (VACANCY) will use a vacancy score of 100. Teams having an incomplete roster (vacancy on the team) will use the average of the lowest average bowler on the opposing team's roster. If two vacancy scores are required, the average of the next-to-the-

lowest-average bowler on the opposing team's roster is used for the second vacancy score. These averages are the basis for the handicap. (Refer to USBC Rule 105, Items d2a and d2b.)

Rule 11. All league games must be bowled as scheduled except when they are postponed or pre-bowled by authorization of the League Secretary or League President. If a team is unable to field a legal lineup for a scheduled game, the game may be bowled up to a week before the scheduled time, or a week after.

The league supervisor/official/committee must grant a postponement when a team is unable to field a legal lineup due to reasons beyond its control. Team and individual unopposed bowling is allowed and scores are recognized for league awards. (Refer to USBC Rule 111e, Item 7.)

Rule 12. A bowler who arrives late may enter the game provided __3__ frames have not been completed. In this situation frames missed may be made up.

Rule 13. A league member may not finish any game of a series before his/her teammates or opponents, except in cases of an emergency or being prearranged based on a good cause. The league coach/president will make the determination. Such scores will count in deciding the game and bowler's average.

Rule 14. Team position standings shall be determined on a point basis, with ____1__ point(s) awarded for each game won and ____1__ point(s) awarded for the high team series in each match. If all teams in the league have not bowled an equal amount of games, position standings are figured using a percentage basis.

Rule 15. A league member may not finish any game of a series before his/her teammates or opponents, except in cases of an emergency or being prearranged based on a good cause. The league supervisor/ official will make the determination. Such scores will count in deciding the game and bowler's average, and for qualifying for USBC Youth awards and league awards.

Rule 16. A playoff will be conducted when there is a tie for first place. Scores bowled in a playoff shall not count toward individual or team averages or special prizes offered by the league.

Rule 17. Any rules not covered here are governed by the USBC rules for youth leagues.
