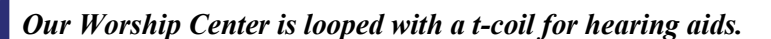

Why don't the poems rhyme? The Bible was written in different cultures, languages, and historical contexts. In this class, we'll dive deep into what's going on in Israel and the surrounding nations. We'll always anchor it in the text of Scripture as well to see exactly why backgrounds matter.

Walking with God in the Desert – John Tooke – Ephesus Room The desert is one of the richest and most helpful images of the Bible. The beauty of the deserts of the Bible lands, the stories set there, and the people of the desert are deeply moving. Days spent in the desert are very hard. In the hardship and struggle to survive in the desert, we find a metaphor for surviving the desert experiences of heart and soul. And yet, God is with us. This series is filmed on location at Biblically significant sights in the Middle East.

Explore the Book: New Testament Overview (NEW TITLE) – Kurt Postma – Philippi Room In the Bible, we see God's full plan of redemption given to us and played out. In "Explore the Book," we'll take a look at one book of the Bible each week and see how it's written, key themes, major characters, and how they each look forward to Jesus Christ. Material will be provided each week. By the end of the class, you'll be able to see the big picture of God's story and be able to identify the theme of each book.
