

Red Cross to Host Virtual Preparedness Sessions for the Public

On June 13th, 15th, and 17th we are offering a public invitation for free Community Preparedness Education Program (CPEP) virtual sessions the third week of June. CPEP is a national, standardized, preparedness education curriculum for adults and older youth taught by a certified presenter. Three available trainings will be offered: "Ready Rating," "Be Red Cross Ready," and "Hands-Only CPR".

Monday, June 13th at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Ready Rating: Organizational emergency preparedness program that helps organizations of all types prepare appropriately, respond effectively, and recover quickly from disasters and other emergencies. Ready Rating tools meet or exceed the minimum standards for organizational preparedness set by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We will also have *Be Red Cross Ready: Preparedness Essentials*. An introductory module on emergency preparedness on a local hazard learning how to prepare, respond appropriately, and basic steps to stay safe after a disaster. The combined offerings should take no more than an hours' time depending on the Q and A.

Wednesday, June 15th at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Hands Only CPR: Individuals will learn the knowledge, skill, and confidence required to administer Hands-Only CPR during sudden cardiac arrest emergencies that occur outside of a hospital setting. This offering will take no more than an hours' time depending on the Q and A.

Friday, June 17th at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Be Red Cross Ready: Home Fire/Floods: An introductory module on emergency preparedness on both home fires and floods, which will go over learning how to prepare, respond appropriately, and basic steps to stay safe after such a disaster. We will also offer again, the *Readiness Rating*. The combine offerings should take no more than an hours' time depending on the Q and A.

I wanted to share this opportunity with you and request your assistance promoting the program to other groups and individuals. The Ready Rating program is designed for business/organizational readiness and the additional two presentations are particularly helpful for individuals.
