A Holiday Thought

Our celebration of Pesach through the Seder and Yom Tov celebration, reinforces the centrality of this holiday in the life and history of *am Yisrael*. The Torah further links this important event with Shabbos and other Yom Tovim as they are a reflection of HaShem's sovereignty over the world. It is the observance of Shabbos which testifies to this and is further linked to the Exodus. The recitation of the daily *Shema* concludes with reference to *zaicher yitziyas mitzrayim*- in remembrance of the Exodus from Egypt. There are many other observances which emphasize this truth.

In an almost prophetic occurrence there is another link Pesach and the other holidays. Thus we find the follows:

- **Tisha B'Av** always falls on the same weekday as the **1st day of Pesach**.
- The 1st day of **Shavuos** always occurs on the same weekday as the **2nd day of Pesach**.
- The 1st day of **Rosh HaShanah** always falls on the same weekday as the **3rd day of Pesach**.
- **Simchas Torah** outside Israel – and in Israel beginning at the end of **Shemini Atzeres**, always occurs on the same weekday as the **4th day of Pesach**.
- **Yom Kippur** always fall out on the **5th day of Pesach**.
- **Purim**, which precedes Pesach, has always occurred on the same weekday as the **6th day of Pesach**.

It is easy to remember these events because they are mnemonics based on the alef-bais. **Tisha b'av** begins with "Tav" the last letter of the alphabet, as opposed to "1", the first day of Pesach.

Shavuos begins with the next letter of the end of the alef-bais, "shin, as opposed to "2".

Rosh Hashana begins with the third to last letter, "raish" as opposed to "3."

• KIDDUSH DETAILS:
