What is Brazilian Embroidery?

Brazilian Embroidery (B.E.) is hand embroidery using z-twist 100% rayon threads. This rayon thread has a high sheen and is capable of supporting three dimensional embroidery stitching. Brazilian Embroidery is washable which makes it a good choice to use on clothing and linens. It is also used to embellish guilts and framed works of art.

The Brazilian Dimensional Embroidery International Guild (BDEIG) was formed in 1991 as a non-profit organization to promote the art of Brazilian Embroidery through seminars, newsletters, Detached Buttonhole Stitch website, and workshops. BDEIG has worldwide membership.
