This site will send a **pre-written** message to Twitter, Facebook, GAB, Parler or email Senators & Congressmen for you, all free of charge. Follow these easy steps to becoming a Republican activist in just minutes!

- ✓ **Open AlignAct.com | *The tools to change history***

You will see a current problem (the day I wrote this the problem was Vaccines for Children)
Take Action Now

- ✓ **Enter your address contact information**
You must do this so they know who your elected representatives are, click **Submit**
(When you come back to this page another time this information will still be filled out so all you have to do is click Submit again)

- ✓ **Email Them:** You will see a list of names to which your email will be sent on the subject you chose. **To view the email message before you send it, click **Confirm****

You will see the message that is to be sent and signed with your name.
Read over your message and then click **Send Now**
If you click **One Click Sign** at the bottom, it takes you to a page where you can post a short note on this same subject to Facebook. The note is already written for you.

- ✓ **Choose a Subject:** On the first page there are other subjects you can choose:
Protect the Senate and the Filibuster - Demand Oversight for Treatment of the Jan 6 Political Prisoners - Stop the Mandates, etc.

Because you filled out your address, you will be sent the names of the representatives to whom you should write. In the case of *Protect the Senate*, I was sent the names of Senators Kyrsten Sinema and Joe Manchin. A pre-written message was written to be sent as soon as I clicked **Send Now**.

- ✓ **Browse Campaigns:** Look at the top of the page for other ideas on which to write. Every time you visit this site you are helping get the Republican message out to our elected representatives.

Staff members of every elected representative count every message that comes in and records whether the writer is for or against an issue. You can be a part of influencing public opinion!

Born and raised in Sweden, Tony Krvaric was inspired by Ronald Reagan's optimism and unshakable belief in free enterprise, individual liberty, and limited government, vowing to one day come to America and pursue his own American Dream.

In 1992 he immigrated legally and arrived in San Diego, starting his own business in the computer industry. Six years later he discovered his passion; helping individuals and families make smart financial choices - and joined A.G. Edwards & Sons as a full service Financial Consultant.

After patiently going through the naturalization process for nearly thirteen years, Tony became an American citizen in 2003, calling it "one of the proudest days" of his life. He immediately registered to vote as a Republican and has never missed an election.

CHAPLAIN—Ginny Wisley

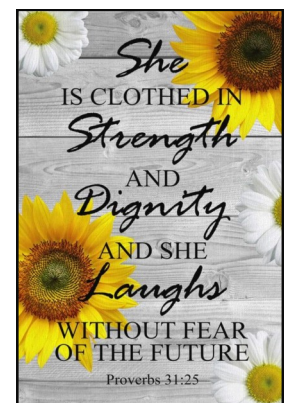
*“She is clothed in Strength & Dignity, & she Laughs without fear of the future;

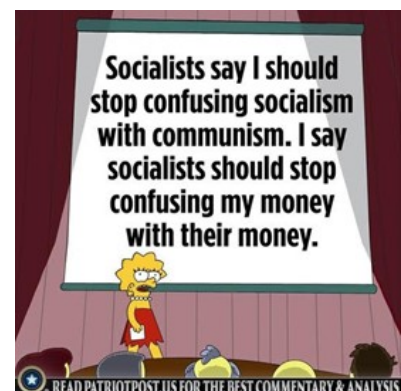
