

Prov 17:1 Better is a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices with strife.

Prov 17:2 A wise servant shall have rule over a son that causeth shame, and shall have part of the inheritance among the brethren.

Prov 17:3 The fining pot is for silver, and the furnace for gold: but the LORD trieth the hearts.

Prov 17:4 A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; and a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue.

Prov 14:15 The simple believeth every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going.

Prov 17:5 Whoso mocketh the poor reproacheth his Maker: and he that is glad at calamities shall not be unpunished.

Prov 17:6 Children's children are the crown of old men; and the glory of children are their fathers.

Prov 17:7 Excellent speech becometh not a fool: much less do lying lips a prince.

Prov 24:7 Wisdom is too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.

Ps 10:5 His ways are always grievous; thy judgments are far above out of his sight: as for all his enemies, he puffeth at them.

Prov 17:8 A gift is as a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth.

Prov 21:14 A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.

Prov 17:9 He that covereth a transgression seeketh love; but he that repeateth a matter separateth very friends.

Jas 5:20 Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

1Cor 1:21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

Dan 2:20 Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:

Matt 6:13 *And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.*

2Pet 2:9 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

Ps 34:15 The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry.

Ps 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

Jer 44:11 Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will set my face against you for evil, and to cut off all Judah.

Job 36:7 He withdraweth not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings are they on the throne; yea, he doth establish them for ever, and they are exalted.

Ps 33:18 Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;

Ps 32:8 I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

Amos 9:4 And though they go into captivity before their enemies, thence will I command the sword, and it shall slay them: and I will set mine eyes upon them for evil, and not for good.

Lev 17:10 And whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

1Sam 14:33 Then they told Saul, saying, Behold, the people sin against the LORD, in that they eat with the blood. And he said, Ye have transgressed: roll a great stone unto me this day.

1Cor 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

1Cor 1:9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Prov 17:13 Whoso rewardeth evil for good, evil shall not depart from his house.

Jer 18:20 Shall evil be recompensed for good? for they have digged a pit for my soul. Remember that I stood before thee to speak good for them, and to turn away thy wrath from them.

Ps 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer.

Prov 17:14 The beginning of strife is as when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

Prov 17:15 He that justifieth the wicked, and he that condemneth the just, even they both are abomination to the LORD.

Prov 18:5 It is not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the righteous in judgment.

Prov 17:16 Wherefore is there a price in the hand of a fool to get wisdom, seeing he hath no heart to it?

Prov 17:17 A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

Ruth 1:16 And Ruth said, Intreat me not to leave thee, or to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God:

2Kgs 2:2 And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said unto him, As the LORD liveth, and as thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

2Kgs 2:4 And Elijah said unto him, Elisha, tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Jericho. And he said, As the LORD liveth, and as thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they came to Jericho.

2Kgs 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

2Kgs 2:12 And Elisha saw it, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.

2Kgs 2:13 He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan;

2Kgs 2:14 And he took the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and smote the waters, and said, Where is the LORD God of Elijah? and when he also had smitten the waters, they parted hither and thither: and Elisha went over.

2Kgs 13:14 Now Elisha was fallen sick of his sickness whereof he died. And Joash the king of Israel came down unto him, and wept over his face, and said, O my father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof.

Prov 17:18 A man void of understanding striketh hands, and becometh surety in the presence of his friend.

Prov 6:1 My son, if thou be surety for thy friend, if thou hast stricken thy hand with a stranger

Prov 17:19 He loveth transgression that loveth strife: and he that exalteth his gate seeketh destruction.

Prov 17:20 He that hath a froward heart findeth no good: and he that hath a perverse tongue falleth into mischief.

Jas 3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

Prov 17:21 He that begetteth a fool doeth it to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.

Prov 10:1 The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother.

Prov 19:13 A foolish son is the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife are a continual dropping.

Prov 21:9 It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.

Prov 21:19 It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.

Rom 3:13 **Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips:**

Ps 5:9 For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue.

Prov 17:22 A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Prov 12:25 Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

Prov 15:13 A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.

Prov 17:22 A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Prov 12:25 Heaviness in the heart of man maketh it stoop: but a good word maketh it glad.

Prov 17:23 A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.

Prov 17:24 Wisdom is before him that hath understanding; but the eyes of a fool are in the ends of the earth.

Eccl 2:14 The wise man's eyes are in his head; but the fool walketh in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happeneth to them all.

Prov 9:2 She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table

Prov 9:3 She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,

Ps 68:11 The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it.

Prov 17:27 He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.

Prov 10:19 In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips is wise.

Jas 1:19 Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:

Prov 14:17 He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated

Prov 16:32 He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.

Prov 19:11 The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and it is his glory to pass over a transgression.
