


Kevin with some Mayan children who came to an outreach in southern Mexico last month. They all received a toy and tracts about Jesus and the church supplied a meal for everyone.


Lucia Potluck & Farewell

LAKE BEAUTY BIBLE CAMP



In 2018 we distributed 81 quilts and 22 pillows. This included Mexico Grace Christian Outreach, Boyd First Responders, Dawson Ambulance, St Cloud Veterans Home, Rice St Outreach Clinic St Paul, Dawson JMHS Hospice, Madison Gifts for Kids, Lac qui Parle Family Services, Madison Safe Avenues and a couple Benefits. We have 3 quilts on hand along with 2 designated for local emergencies. That makes a total of 86 and there are also about a dozen others in progress.
