  - Cam- WR Reverse off WR screen
  - “Big” Cam- Fake Screen, fake reverse, throw the Go
  - Arena- From Coach Kevin Kelley
  - Twister- Spacing route Hitch & Pitch
  - Deal- Behind the back Rollout Draw
  - Bench Lighting- Double move on Rollout
  - HBO
  - Letter Screen: Triple screen
  - “Big” Outtie
  - Oreo: Double Pass/Throwback Screen
  - Oro: Sweep Reverse, throwback to QB
  - Oregon: Sweep Reverse off audible action
  - “Ones”: When/why QB sneak, using cadence as a weapon
  - Rooskie: Counter to the QB sneak
  - Rooster: Shotgun version of fumblerooskie
  - Outtie Picket: For the athletic QB
  - Flipper: Clutch down play, from Coach Kevin Kelley
  - Hide It/Do It: First sound, great after 1<sup>st</sup> Down
  - Quads Naked: Hash 2-point conversion play, Pass/Run/Pass Option
  - El Nino: WR hide play, disguise with motion
