Gratitude in Action: Our Way of Life

Christian Stewards are messengers for God. We share Him when we tell others all we have been given and possess, all we are – everything about us, our life in its fullness – are gifts from God who created us and breathed His life into us. This God continues to watch over and guide our every step.

We share God each time we receive His precious Body and Blood in Holy Communion and then carry Him within the tabernacle of our own bodies into the world around us, a world that often does not know Him or wish to know Him. We are His hands and feet, His voice, His outstretched, welcoming arms to those hurting and troubled in our society.

We receive the Living Presence in the Holy Eucharist and thus become that Presence to those we encounter. We know this Living Presence, this *Bread of Life* and *Cup of Salvation*, is our path to eternal life. We are a converted people with a responsibility to reach out to others.

Our parish is a member of the St. George Interfaith Council. The Council has engaged our local faith communities to offer a prayer prior to lunch served on Tuesdays and Fridays at the Washington County Senior Center. Those present for lunch have often expressed their thanks and appreciation for the special prayer.

This past week, I received an email invitation to participate on the remaining luncheon dates this year. The very next day, I received an email indicating there would no longer be lunch prayers offered.

One woman who regularly eats lunch at the nearby Senior Center was so opposed to the prayers being offered, she sent a letter to the person at the Center responsible for this activity, who in turn took the letter to her supervisors. The final decision was no prayers would be offered at any of the three Senior Centers in Washington County.

How sad it is that one person's voice has denied all the right to prayer. Brothers and Sisters, we are called to be like Jesus, loving, kind and forgiving, even in the face of hatred. We must also be vigilant of those alienated from God, who attempt to alienate others as well.
