STATE CONTEST INFORMATION

- 2019 NBTA rules will be in effect
- Order of performance & lane assignments will be listed in state program. Pageant contestants: will perform in alphabetic order starting with the letter "E". All modeling events: will also start with the letter "E". Group events, Show Twirl, Rhythmic Twirl and Collegiate Twirl: will be listed in state program. Sunday Individual Events: The first entries to be received will be the last to perform. The last entries to be received will be the first to perform. The order of performance will be listed in the state program.
- Contest floor reserved for contestants and contest officials only. Practice area provided on Saturday and Sunday.
- Contestants must wear tennis shoes or rubber sole dance shoes on the facility floor.
- Food and drinks will be available. No outside food or drinks allowed in facility. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on facility premises. No smoking allowed.
- ADMISSION: in order to eliminate long lines to enter facility, there is a door/facility surcharge of \$38.00 attached to each individual entry. If there is more than one child in a family, only one surcharge will be charged, but these entries must be sent together. This surcharge eliminates facility practice fee and daily admission fees. All parents, relatives, and friends will be admitted at no charge.

In the modeling competition, all contestants shall first model in a circle T pattern and upon judge's signal, walk to the judges table for a short sit-down interview.

Top 3 Advanced pageant winners are eligible to represent the State of Texas in the Miss Majorette of America Pageant at AYOP. Only first place Beginner and Intermediate winners are eligible to represent the State of Texas in the Beginner and Intermediate Pageant at AYOP. All college participants are eligible for College Miss Majorette of America Pageant at AYOP.

RULE CLARIFICATIONS

1. CONTEST AGE: Competitors actual age on September 1, 2018, determines competitive age.
2. No membership or insurance fees are required to participate in NBTA contest.
3. All twirlers from all organizations welcome.
4. Contestant Classification – No double entering
NOVICE: Never won 5 First Place Awards or First Place in Higher Division. BEGINNER: Never won 5 First Place Awards in Beginner Level Competition or First Place in Higher Division. INTERMEDIATE: Never won 8 First Place Awards in Intermediate Level Competition or First Place in Higher Division.
5. No gymnastics allowed – body aerials, walkovers, cartwheels, butterflies, somersaults on floor – penalty is disqualification.
6. Protection Rule: Applies at local, state and regional competitions. Should a novice, beginner or intermediate contestant not demonstrate first place ability, the judge may use 1st place "protection rule" to prevent win from counting towards advancement. Awards will be presented as advertised.
7. A state and/or regional beginner contestant may win beginner pageant title two times. A state and/or regional intermediate contestant may win intermediate pageant title two times. This repeat pageant ruling does not apply to 0-6 Tiny Tot pageant division. The number of 0-6 beginner and intermediate pageant wins is unrestricted.
8. Rhythmic Twirl: Advance twirlers only, one baton only, no props. Individually selected CD music. Judging begins with first note of music and ends with last note of music.
