## 2019 Placement and Awards Determination Rules

All placements are based on points calculation, and if needed Tiebreaking rules. A playoff position is based on points after the 3rd game is completed. All results and awards determined from on field scoreboard results.

## Placement Determination

Determined by total points awarding:

1. Three points for a win
2. One point for a tie
3. Zero points for a loss

Cancelled games will be recorded as a 1-1 tie.
Forfeited games will be recorded as a 3-0 loss.

## Tiebreaking Rules - Used when points are equal

1. Results of head-to-head competition (only if 2 teams are tied, more tied skip to next tiebreaker)
2. Goal Differential (the maximum can be + or -5 for each game played).
3. Team with most wins.
4. Team with least goals scored against (count all goals - no limit).
5. Team with most shutouts (A 0-0 tie is not considered a shutout).
6. Team with most goals (the maximum counted is 7 per game).

In a playoff format flight after $3^{\text {rd }}$ game if an in-bracket tie still exists after tiebreakers are applied, a coin flip administered by Site Manager between tied teams determines $4^{\text {th }}$ and final playoff game position.

## Awards Determination When Ties Are Involved

If a playoff Championship ends in a tie, duplicate awards will be given to both teams as if both won the game. In a round robin format, if a tie still exists after all tiebreakers are exhausted, both teams are given the higher award being contested for. If awards are not in stock, get shipping name and address and roster count from head coach.

## Levels Of Awards
