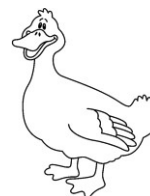

 3. Individual competitors may qualify no more than two birds for each final.
 4. Chickens qualifying for entry in the final may not be entered in any other classes at Swinford Show.
 5. The chickens must be ready for exhibition at the show grounds by 10.30am.
 6. Final to be judged at 1pm.
 7. These rules should be read in conjunction with the ISA Rules.
