If your interested in joining us RSVP at the link below or call the church office at 899-5962 so we can have plenty of eggs to pass out for everyone!



SERMON TITLE: LIVING THE EXCHANGED LIFE, GIVING MY ALL

Galatians 2:20; Matthew 16:24-27; Romans 12:1

LYRICS to "CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST" by Phillips, Craig & Dean As I look back on what I thought was living I'm amazed at the price I chose to pay And to think I ignored what really mattered 'Cause I thought the sacrifice would be too great

But when I finally reached the point of giving in I found the cross was calling even then And even though it took dying to survive I've never felt so much alive

For I am crucified with Christ and yet I live Not I, but Christ that lives within me

His Cross will never ask for more than I can give For it's not my strength but His There's no greater sacrifice for I am crucified with Christ And yet I live

As I hear the Savior call for daily dying I will bow beneath the weight of Calvary Let my hands surrender to His piercing purpose That holds me to the cross **YET SETS ME FREE**

I will glory in the power of the cross
The things I thought were gain now I count as loss
And with His suffering I identify
And by His resurrection power --- I AM ALIVE!

For I am crucified with Christ and yet I live
Not I but Christ that lives within me

And I WILL OFFER ALL I HAVE SO THAT His cross is not in vain For I found to live is Christ and to die [to self] is truly gain

LIVING THE EXCHANGED LIFE, GIVING MY ALL

"The world has yet to see what God can do with and for and thru and in one person FULLY CONSECRATED to God." British Evangelist, Henry Varley to D.L. Moody, 1873

I have been crucified with Christ and I NO LONGER LIVE, BUT CHRIST LIVES IN ME. The life I NOW LIVE in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, WHO LOVED ME AND GAVE HIMSELF FOR ME. **(Galatians 2:20)**

Then Jesus said to his disciple, WHOEVER, wants to be my disciple must:

- 1. DENY THEMSELVES
- 2. TAKE UP THEIR CROSS
- 3. FOLLOW ME

FOR whoever wants to save their life (soul) will NEED TO LOSE IT, BUT whoever loses their life (soul) for me WILL FIND IT.

What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, YET forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give IN EXCHANGE FOR THEIR SOUL? (Matthew 16:24-26)

For to me, TO LIVE IS CHRIST and to die is gain. (Philippians 1:21)

But, whatever were gains to me I now consider as loss FOR THE SAKE OF JESUS CHRIST. What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things (i.e. I have surrendered and abandoned all things) ... but I consider them garbage, SO THAT I may gain Christ AND be found in him Not because of anything I have done, BUT **only through the righteousness of Christ – the righteousness of God that comes to us only by faith in Him. (Philippians 3:7-9)**

Therefore, **IF ANYONE IS IN CHRIST --- THE NEW CREATION HAS COME** --- The old has gone and the NEW IS HERE! **(2 Corinthians 5:17)**
