

Professor (Dr) Basani Shankariah was born and brought up in Shayampet (Village & Mandal), Parkal (Taluka). Even though he came from a very poor weaving family, he was brilliant at studies. He served as Professor in NIT Warangal for many years and as the first Principal of Vaagdevi Engineering College. He laid a strong foundation for Vaagdevi College in processes, discipline and physical infrastructure. He strongly believed that Education is key to both Success and Empowerment.

Late Dr. B. Shankariah was a very strong follower of Swami Vivekananda. He embodied some of the core principles and values taught by SwamiJi such as work (Karma Yoga – Selfless service to community), worship (Bhakti Yoga – Egoless actions), philosophy (Jnana Yoga – Education and imparting knowledge) and psychic control (Raja Yoga – Yoga practice and preaching).
