

Thank You to ALL who assisted in any way with our 43rd consecutive Tootsie Roll sale!

This years sale was delayed by the State Directors from the spring to the fall dates of the Christopher Columbus weekend due to the pandemic. There was a lot of work to do to make the sale happen in a short time but it ended with excellent results!

Weeks before the sale no one really knew if the City of Monroe would even allow us to conduct the sale on the streets. But when we showed them our state mandated safety apparel and selling strategy they granted us permission for the sale. When we received the cities permission everything kicked into high speed catch up mode. At first one of the local banks would not give us permission to sell but later change their mind. Understandably there were Hawkers who were concerned about selling on the streets. A few of the local businesses also had concerns. The luncheon menu and serving procedures had to be realigned for safety sake. BUT, it did all come together with the sale actually totaling \$ 1,369.87 more than the 2019 sale!

Thank you to Matt Hehl for his help with First Merchants Bank. Thanks to the students of the SMCC Brother Brad Flint Mission Club that sold at 9 off street sites for a total sale of close to \$ 1,000.00. Thanks to all of our members who sold either on the street or at store fronts. Thank you Sharon who served up a tasty luncheon for no charge.

For those that do not know about our program it was started by our Council in 1914 with the purpose of serving a hardy Christmas dinner to families in need in the City of Monroe. This is the 106th consecutive year for this program! Think of the wars years and the depression years when this food was really needed. We have a special need this year with the pandemic! Our services have expanded greatly through the years. We now deliver food throughout Monroe County. The amount of food we now deliver provides daily meals for a week. We are also providing monthly donations to all the Parishes of our council to be used for their needy. We also assist our Council in numerous charitable and religious projects. The money for all these services comes from our annual Goodfellows Paper Sale.

Please consider helping this cause in one or more of the listed ways. Ask anyone who has assisted in this program and they will tell you of the pride and brotherhood you will feel for helping those in need.



December the 5th is the Paper Sale. We do need help as "Hawkers" to sell our papers on the streets. The Saturday starts with coffee and do-nuts at 8ish. The sale is from 9AM till 12noon. The next big date is Wednesday December the 23rd. This is when the food boxes are packed. The packaging starts at 6PM in Hall #2. If you are interested in assisting in the box packing contact PGK Joe Lamour at the print shop at 24-1-6006.



The final step in the food program is the delivery of boxes to the needy families on Christmas Eve morning. If you are interested in working this day we need help to load the trucks and help to deliver the boxes. We meet at the hall at 9ish. There are usually about 6 to 8 boxes per route.
