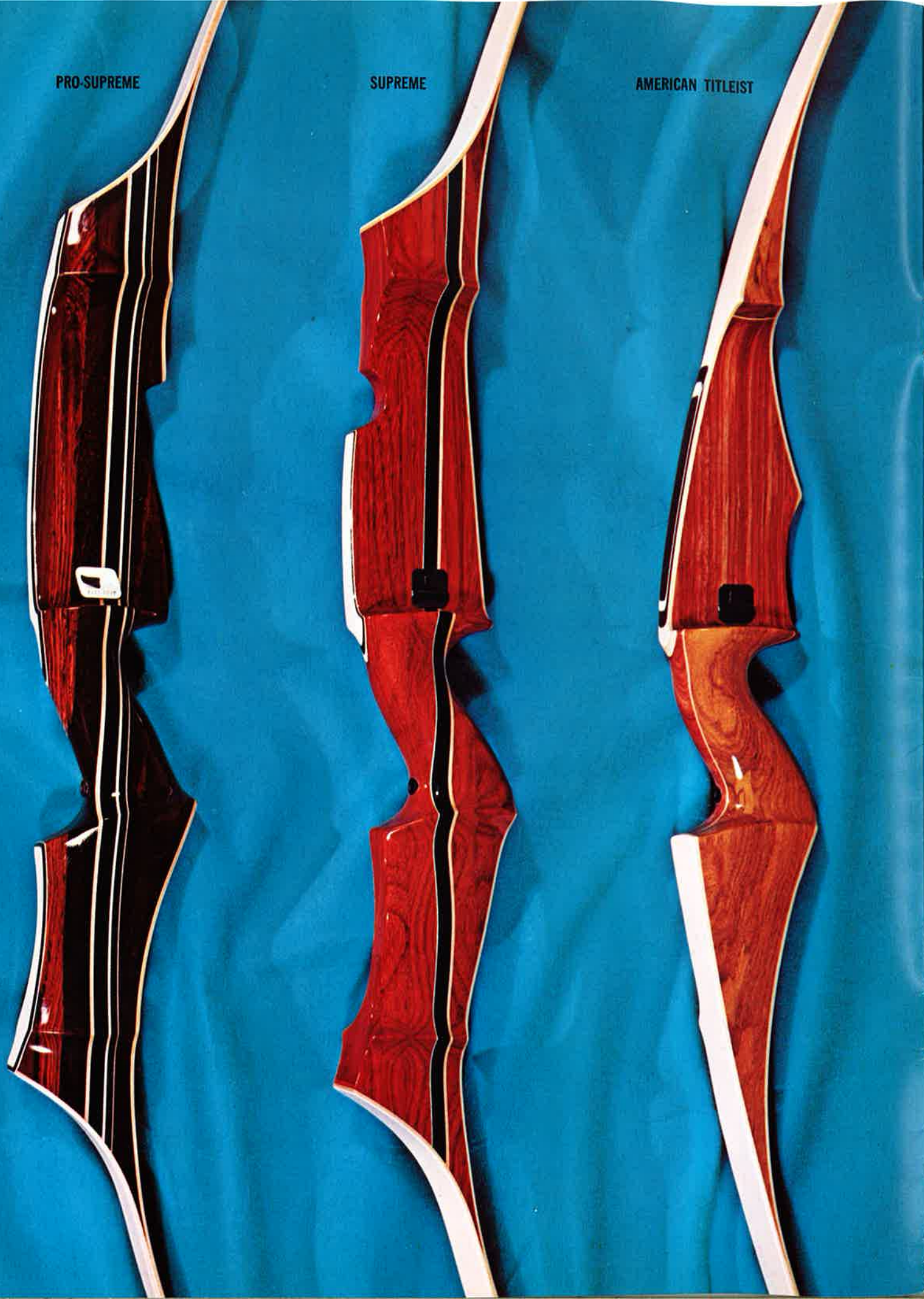

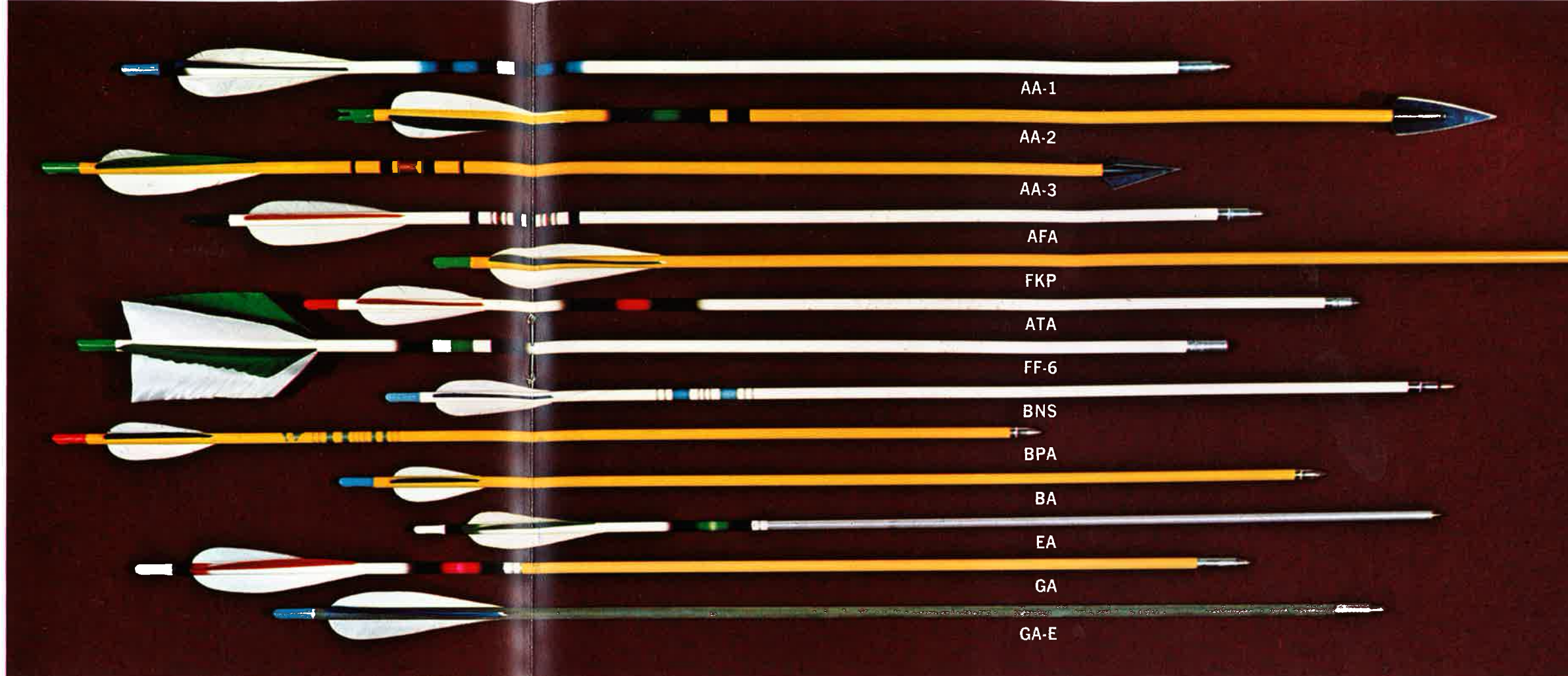




ARROWS BY AMERICAN

"Micro-barrelled" means the front and nock ends are tapered slightly, giving you an arrow with the center portion slightly stiffer. "Micro-barrelled" arrows give you better arrow clearance, greater penetration, because there's more mass up front where it counts. They stay straighter longer.

CROSS SECTION OF A DEER

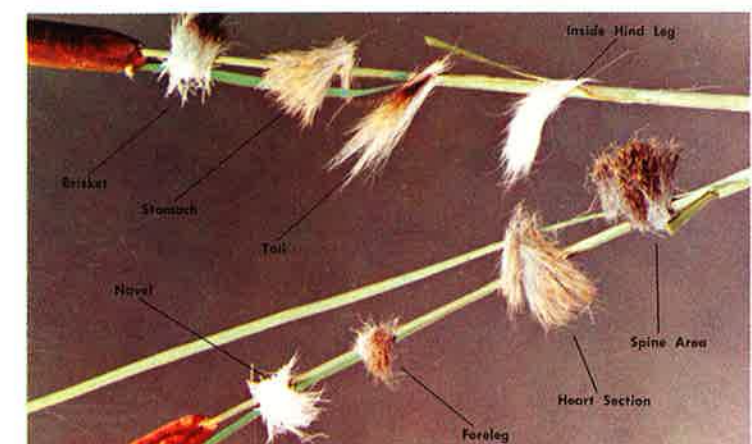
- LUNGS**—Largest quick killing target; just back of shoulder.
- HEART**—Inflated lungs in live deer are larger than in this picture of dead deer.
- SPINE**—Quick kill; best target area lies in shoulder just above heart and lungs.
- LIVER**—Presses against lung cavity from behind diaphragm. Killing hit.
- KIDNEY**—High, just behind ribs; certain kill.
- NECK**—Center and under half is killing hit; top part not serious wound.
- NAVEL**—Releases intestines; always killing.
- BRISKET**—Killing if high; low it is not serious wound; best if hit from front.



KINDS OF DEER HAIR

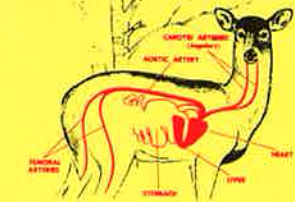
EACH PORTION OF DEER'S BODY CLOTHED WITH DISTINCTIVE HAIR. FIND HAIR ON GROUND AND ON ARROW; IDENTIFY LOCATION OF WOUND (SEE DIAGRAM ABOVE).

- STOMACH HAIR**—Hair from stomach wound; coarse, hollow, brownish grey; tips are not dark as is hair from spine area.
- NAVEL HAIR**—White, coarse, hollow, curly, twisted.
- HAIR FROM FORELEG**—Dark, short, medium coarse.
- HAIR FROM BETWEEN HIND LEGS**—Fine, white, silky, not hollow, tendency to curled tips.
- DEER TAIL**—Long, coarse and wavy; black or greyish brown on top to pure white underneath.
- SPINE AREA**—Dark with black tips; long, coarse, hollow.
- HEART**—Long dark guard hairs found only over heart greying with age.
- BRISKET**—Stiff and greyish black; curly, coarse.



BLOOD VESSELS OF A DEER

MAIN ARTERIES AND VEINS—These furnish killing targets as effective as heart, lung, spine, liver or kidney shots. Cutting the femoral artery on the inside of a deer's hind leg is as serious as cutting a man's wrist, in its effect. The two jugulars or carotid arteries run on either side of the wind pipe, on the under side of the spine, in the neck. The aortic artery runs the length of a deer's body beneath the spine. The renal caval artery connects the heart with spleen and liver. Pyloric artery connects the stomach and heart. Principal veins return blood to the heart along similar routes. These arteries and veins are tough and flexible. Broadhead blades must be kept razor sharp to enable cutting of these vessels. Dull edges result in pushing vessels aside, failure to inflict killing wound. Give hit deer one hour, at least, to bleed out, with two exceptions. leg hit deer should be pressed immediately, but slowly; Belly hit deer should be given 4 to 8 hours before trailing. Blood vessels in belly seldom severed.



THE HEART SHOT

Deer usually leaps wildly when hit. Long brown or greyish guard hair on ground and sometimes on arrow. Sometimes no blood first 20 yards. Blood on arrow if passed through. Increasing blood sign as you follow trail. Will usually collapse at 80 yards, may travel 400 yards. Rare instances of 700 yards.

THE LUNG SHOT

Runs straight and hard at first, slower after 50 yards, then meanders. At end will stagger and stand. Blood sign will be smears on bushes or high

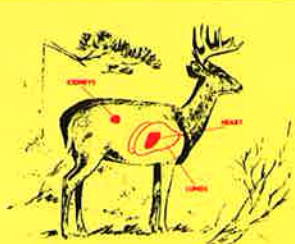
THE BELLY SHOT

IN CASE A HIT IS MADE IN THIS AREA DO NOT BE DISCOURAGED. ALL BELLY SHOT DEER DIE AND CAN BE RECOVERED IF TRAILED AFTER 4 TO 8 HOURS. When hit in belly, deer may just walk away, starting with a few short jumps. Usually walks or runs with legs widespread and with hunched back. Lies down soon, if not followed. Hair is coarse, shorter than on back or lung areas, lighter in color and without black tips (the lower down on the belly, the

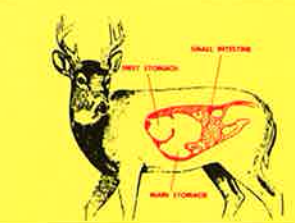
lighter the hair is in color). Tips of hair are reddish brown. Note picture of hair.

THE KIDNEY SHOT

Hair longer and darker than from lung area; may have black tips. Bleeds profusely and usually immediately. Deer may take two or three jumps and then walk away. Will fall within 80 yards.



Very little blood sign. Blood often darker because of infusion of stomach or intestinal material. Flecks of food particles, if stomach penetrated. Greenish, slimy material if intestines punctured.



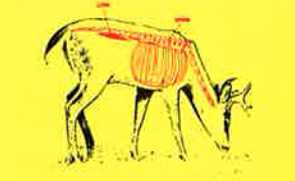
Do not trail until 4 hours have elapsed in cold weather or 8 hours in warm weather. Usually, you will have to dispatch this deer.

SPINE HITS

A hit in spine drops deer in his tracks. Here, by spine, we mean the backbone extending from the base of the head to within six inches of base of tail.

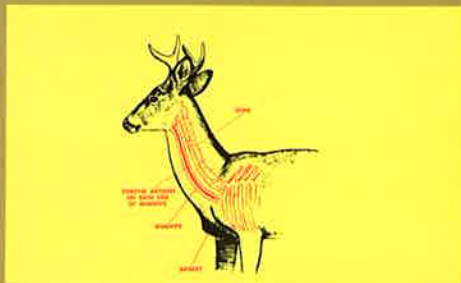
BACK HITS

Above the kidneys and loin, large amounts of tallow are present under skin (note cross-section picture). Tallow on arrow, and blood, may be on one or two feathers. Hair is long, coarse, dark and black-tipped. After resting few days, deer will be healthy as ever. May still hunt him down, but not as result of this wound. May bleed for 200 yards.



NECK HIT

Arrow passing through beneath spine will cut jugulars and/or windpipe, but may pass through so fast as to be wiped clean of blood. Wound bleeds heavily, so look for trail. Deer will be found in 50 to 80 yards. A deer hit above spine, at base of neck, bleeds so profusely as to indicate mortal neck or chest wound. However, this deer will stop bleeding after 200 yards if not seriously wounded. Hair on neck is short, coarse and light colored, underneath, but above spine it is dark and black tipped. Any other hit above spine between head and base of neck will bleed but wound not likely to be serious.



BRISKET HIT

Brisket hair easily identified. Arrow will be coated with tallow. If shot from side through brisket, wound is not serious but may bleed small amount. If shot head-on, may penetrate chest cavity, bleed heavily

from heart or lung wound. Arrow may slide along rib cage, bleed for short time but prove harmless. Thus brisket hit is either harmless or killing, depending upon angle of hit and penetration. Amount of bleeding tells story.

HIND LEGS FROM SIDE

If femoral artery is severed, deer will bleed out quickly and have seen them picked up in less than 100 yards. Hit too low or too high on leg may not prove serious wound. Femoral artery lies inward from leg bone, so it is not likely to be severed on side shot unless hit heavily enough to smash through leg bone. However, serious bleeding may result from severance of leg veins. Press this deer closely enough to keep him walking steadily without lying down, and, so that he doesn't run. If lies down, will run when jumped. Then blood will emit in fine spray and trailing prove difficult. Walking trail will be good. Trail leg wounded deer at once, steadily, slowly. You can get him.



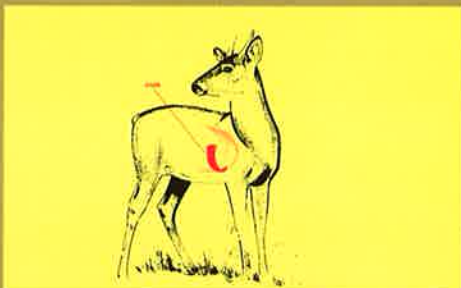
this angle. Hair will be white, silky and with curled tips over femoral artery. Hair will be short, coarse, reddish grey in color and with guard hairs from rear center of leg toward outside. This hit should be trailed steadily, slowly, as above.

HIND LEGS FROM REAR

You have a better chance at femoral artery from

LIVER SHOT

Liver lies next to diaphragm on right side in football-like dome angling toward chest cavity. Liver-shot deer are dead deer; won't go more than 1/4 mile. Blood trail fair; internal bleeding. Hair over liver is pointed belly hair. Allow one hour before trailing.



they may consume your trophy. These marauders may be kept away from your deer overnight, if you hang articles of clothing around the area, as they fear this scent.

NIGHT TRAILING

You should not leave deer for overnight if rain forecast; it would wash out blood trail. Just in case you do get rained out, look for ravens next morning to point location of deer. Night trailing with a gas lantern is practical and as easy as trailing in daylight. Leave weapons home and it is legal in most states - check this with your warden. Advisable to pick up deer at night when well hit at dusk, especially when fox, coyote and bear are numerous;

1. Keep broadheads very sharp.
2. Watch location of hit on deer and his location on the ground. Mark spot where he disappeared from view.
3. Find arrow and correctly interpret looks of blood, hair, food particles, slime, tallow.
4. Be perfect in identifying deer hair, then you will use correct trailing tactics.
5. Trail by finding blood smears on vegetation or in drops on trail. Look for fine spray or foam which indicates running deer.
6. Wait many hours before trailing belly hit deer and at least one hour for all other hits except leg hit which should be trailed at once, steadily and slowly.
7. If you lose trail, look for ravens which will hover over wounded deer.
8. Post other members of party at likely crossings around trailing area. They may get shots at other deer.
9. Be calm; set up unobstructed shot.
10. Follow state laws and be a good sport.

TIPS ON BOW CARE

1. Store your bow in a cool, dry place. We recommend hanging your bow on two pegs with the limb tips pointing down and UNSTRUNG.
2. Periodically wax your bow with a high grade wax.
3. Use a protective bow case to avoid scratches and dents.
4. Periodically replace bow string.
5. Proper Stringing . . . Improper bow stringing may seriously damage your bow. The two most used methods of stringing a bow used by most experts: 1. The Bow Stringer, and 2, The push-pull method as follows:
 - a. The right hand has grasped the bow at the handle and the elbow is held in close to the body. The palm of the left hand is placed on the back of the bow with the thumb and forefinger free to slide the string up the bow when the bracing action takes place. The tip of the bow is placed against the instep. The main weight of the body is on the left leg. Do not allow the bow tip to touch the ground.
 - b. The bracing action starts by pulling with the right hand as the weight of your body shifts from the left to the right leg. This is the most important part to learn. Actually the hip muscles and the shifting of your weight do most of the work, while the left hand acts as a brace.
 - c. Make sure that the right hand is pulling or the bow won't bend enough to allow the string to slide up the back. Pushing too hard with the left hand is a common mistake of bow stringing. Try this method with a light weight bow first, and you'll develop the right knack.
 - d. After the bow is strung, it is important to carefully check both ends to make sure the string is seated properly in the string grooves. The step-through method of stringing is no longer considered proper for recurve bows. Continued use of this method can easily twist the lower limb and ultimately result in breakage. This type of breakage will NOT be honored in the guarantee.
6. To measure brace height (fistmele) measure at right angles to the string from the deepest cut in the handle on the face of the bow. The proper height depends almost entirely on your own shooting style. Therefore, it is important that you tune your bowstring to your bow before each shooting session. The best brace height will give you (a) The least straining noise and vibration, (b) The least wrist slap, (c) An arrow that does not wobble in flight.

Selecting Correct Arrows Preferred Method—Method 1



Draw a measuring arrow (marked in inches) in your bow. At full draw, your correct length is the point at which the arrow stops in relation to the front of the arrow shelf. See illustration above.

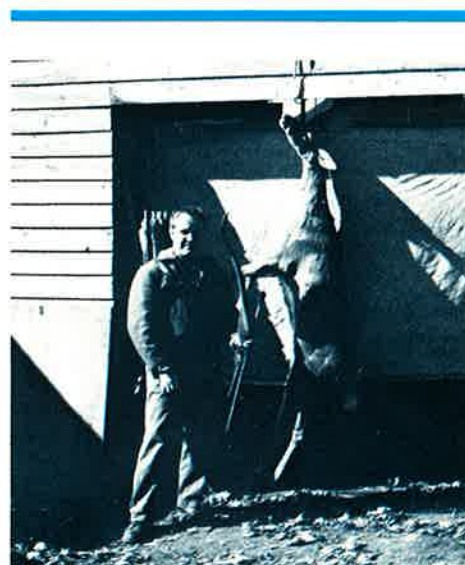

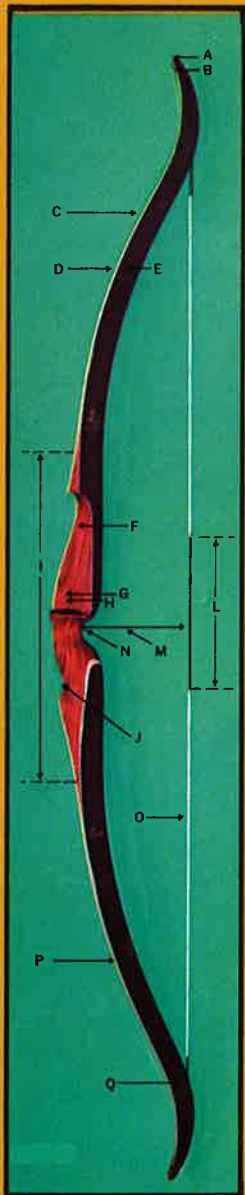
AMO BOW AND ARROW NOMENCLATURE

In February 1968, the Archery Manufacturers Organization officially adopted these AMO Manufacturing Standards for Bows, Bow Strings and Wood Arrows.

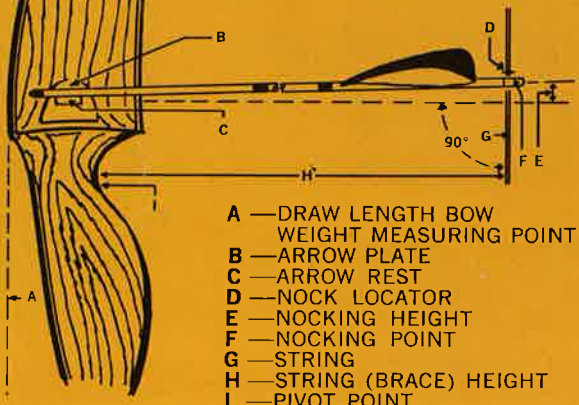
As part of this program, the nomenclature or words used to describe the many parts of a bow and an arrow were agreed on. Archers, dealers and the public have been confused by the industry's use of interchangeable words (i.e. Fistmele and String Height). By using common simple terms this confusion will be lessened.

Diagram, at left, illustrates the Standard Nomenclature as approved by the Archery Manufacturers Organization and recommended by the American Archery Council.

AMO BOW WEIGHT STANDARD

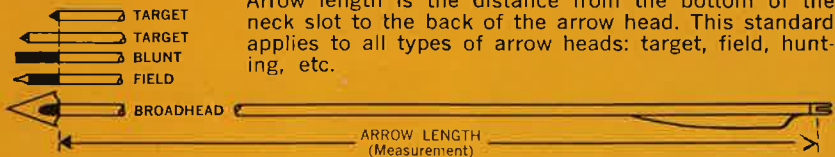
Bow weight is the force required to draw the bow string 28" from the back of the bow at the arrow rest.

AMO DRAW LENGTH STANDARD

Draw length is the distance, at archer's full draw, from the nocking point on the string to the back of the bow at the arrow rest.

AMO ARROW LENGTH STANDARD

Arrow length is the distance from the bottom of the neck slot to the back of the arrow head. This standard applies to all types of arrow heads: target, field, hunting, etc.



GUARANTEE

Every bow is numbered and accompanied by a registration card which must be filled out and mailed by the dealer or purchaser within ten days after date of purchase.

Should any failure occur in this bow within a period of 6 months from the date of purchase, American Archery Company will make free repair, or replacement if repair is not feasible, unless the bow shows evidence of misuse or improper handling, or any modification to the bow.

This warranty is transferable from one owner to another, provided bow is registered at time of purchase by the original owner.

After 6 months and up to one year from date of purchase, and provided the bow has not been misused or mishandled, repair or replacement will be made for 25% of the list purchase price.

From 1 year to 1½ years from date of purchase, the charge will be 50% of the list purchase price.

From one and one half years to 3 years, the charge will be 75% of the list purchase price. No adjustment will be made until damaged bow is returned to American Archery Company for inspection. Replacement if necessary will be made with a bow of the same model and weight, as nearly as possible. Dealers are not authorized to make adjustments, but will be glad to handle the shipping and correspondence.
