You will be able to teach the basics of the English language from K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade these skills in an explicit, sequential, and systematic way: decoding (reading), encoding (spelling), fluency, comprehension, and printing.

Who can train? Unlike many OG training classes, you are not required to have a college degree. You must, however, pass a simple, auditory discretion screening to identify the sounds in the English language. We can do that on the phone. Other requirements: lots of patience and a love for phonics and helping children.
