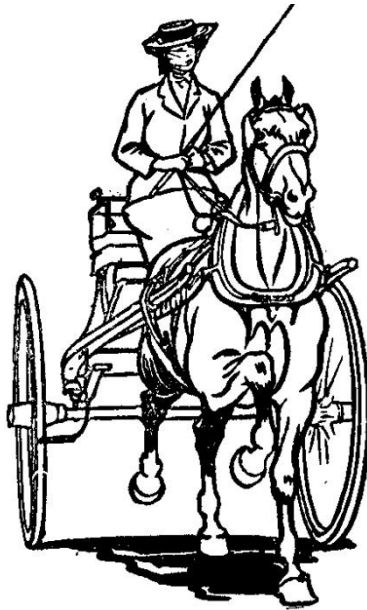

## **GENERAL RULES& REGULATIONS IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER**

**ATTIRE & VEHICLES:** Dress of whip and passengers and appropriateness of is open to interpretation.

**CLASS CANCELLATION:** The Show Manager reserve the right to suspend competition, or cancel any class. Classes with less than four entries may be cancelled.

**CLASS FEES:** See Entry form.

**COMPETITOR PACKETS** may be picked up Sunday morning at the Show Secretary Desk. The Secretary Desk will open at 7:30 am on Sunday.

**COURTESY:** Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges, or Show Officials on the part of a competitor, owner, driver, passenger, groom, will disqualify said entry from further competition & shall forfeit any and all fees.

**DIVISIONS:** Divisions are as follows:

HORSE

PONY

VERY SMALL EQUINE (VSE) open to any horse or pony that measures up to and including 34inches.

JUNIOR

Multiples are welcome and will be included in the above divisions.

**ENTRIES:** An entry is defined as the driver, horse (or horses, if a pair) and vehicle. A change of any one of the three constitutes a separate entry, and requires a new entry form, and a new entry number.

**ENTRIES OPEN** May 1<sup>st</sup> and **ENTRIES CLOSE** June 10th, 2017. Entries received after June 3<sup>rd</sup> will be assessed a Late Fee.

**SIGNED ENTRY** acknowledges that you have read, understand, and agree to abide by the conditions set forth in the competition Prize List. Every entrant is responsible for knowledge of and subject to information in the Prize List. Your check to cover show fees must accompany your entry form.

**JUNIORS** are entries 16 years old and under and must wear approved helmets.

## **DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES**

**Working-** Competitors are judged primarily on the suitability of the horse to provide a safe and pleasant drive.

**Reinsmanship-** Competitors are judged primarily on the ability and skill of the driver. **Pattern-**The Judge will ask for a pattern that may include, the 3 gaits, a circle and/or rein back. Work will be done individually in the ring-Judged on accuracy.

**Cones or Obstacles-** The driver is judged on the speed, accuracy and lack of penalties, while going through a set of cones obstacles topped with balls. The driver who completes the course with the least number of penalty faults in the shortest time wins.

“As long as your equine is trained to drive you can compete. Your equine will not be judged on conformation or breeding, but rather on their fitness, condition, movement and responsiveness to the cues of the driver. “

**DESCRIPTION OF GAITS-**The judge may instruct competitors to halt, rein back (back your horse), and/or perform a figure eight-and a change of gaits as they drive in the ring.

**Walk-**“A free, regular and unconstrained walk of moderate extension. Horse should walk energetically but calmly with even determined steps.”

**Slow Trot-** “The horse should maintain forward impulsion while showing submission to the bit. The **slow** trot is slower and more collected than the working and strong trots.”

**Working Trot** “This is a pace between a slow trot and a strong trot. The position should be balanced and unconstrained, steps as even as possible. The hind feet touch the ground in the footprints of the forefeet. The degree of energy and impulsion displayed at the working trot denotes clearly the degree of suppleness and balance of the horse.”

**Strong Trot-** “The judge will call out “trot on”. This is a clear, lengthening of stride while remaining well-balanced and showing appropriate lateral flexion on turns. Excessive speed is penalized.” The lengthening of stride is what increases the pace.

**KNOX FARM STATE PARK EQUESTRIAN PERMIT:** *Required of ALL competitors!* The permit can be downloaded from our website and will be provided at the secretary's desk the day of the show.

**SCHOOLING:** A Schooling area will be provided in the warm up area.
