Words from the Director of Coaches

First, thanks to all the coaches who have volunteered their time and energy to coach for us this year. We would not be able to run our league without your help, and your commitment to the players and their families is appreciated.

Second, as we continue with our 12th season of BRYSL soccer, please remember that we are guests at the Kern County Soccer Park and at the BCSD schools where some of our teams practice each week. We have worked hard over the last decade to build a good rapport with the KCSP and BCSD, so please help us continue that good relationship by cleaning up after your team and following the facility rules. If your coach is practicing at a BCSD school, please remember that we do not have access to the restrooms, so plan accordingly. The park guidelines are listed in the handbooks that each player/family who registers receives when registering, as well as on our website and sometimes in this newsletter.

Lastly, please remember that teams are to sit on opposite sides of the field. We do this to prevent any possible situations that might arise (and they do) when games get competitive. The home team (first team listed on the schedule) sits on the north side of the field (for fields with an E-W orientation) or on the East side (for fields with a N-S orientation). Every team has the same number of home and away games, so if you are scheduled to be in the sun, again, please plan accordingly. Again, thanks to the coaches and assistant coaches, and for all the volunteers who are helping this season!
