Thank you all for your interest in MLOTC 2020 Spring Agility. We are offering two classes this spring, beginner agility and a drills class. Unfortunately, there will be no contact obstacles at these classes, but summer classes we will introduce contact obstacles, so look out for those classes as well. These classes will run for four weeks, and be around 50-60 minutes long. They will be held at 5585 Sternburg Rd Fruitport, MI. These classes start March 29th through April 26th. We will be SKIPPING Easter Day. Class size is limited, turn in your application to secure your spot. We will post on the MLOTC facebook page when we are full. Classes will cost \$50. We stress that you please bring a crate to practice so there can be more 1 on 1 training as well as group training.
