Hello Church,

For those of us in our region of the world we look forward to the amazing colors that will paint the forests of Pennsylvania and Maryland, but I often wonder what it would have been like for a visitor to our area from a region of the world years ago when communication was not so widespread?

Without someone to help them understand what was happening they may conclude that something terrible is happening. Maybe, even thinking all the trees are dying from some unknown cause. Would have they seen something temporary as something permanent?

In our Christian life we have many trials, and it can be easy to feel like they are permanent. We can look at the spiritual warfare that exists and comes against us when we take new steps of faith and think something strange is happening to us or wonder what went wrong. Peter, however, reminds the Church that difficulties that arise when following after Jesus are not strange, for Jesus also suffered in His obedience to the Father. But they are not the end of the story, for Joy and God's glory will be revealed and victory is His.

[1 Peter 4:12-13 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy.]

In the same way we know the spring will bring amazing beauty we trust and know that God's glory will be shared with us who endure and look to Him in the times of difficulty. I pray that when those times arise, as they will, we will look not just at the struggle but look towards the coming glory!
