Issues & Opportunity Identification for Community Members

We want you to get involved in the Community Plan Update process! The following exercises are designed to help identify issues and opportunities within your Community Plan Area. If you are a community member, Neighborhood Council member, or affiliated with another group, your answers to these questions will help us identify community values, set plan priorities, and develop project goals as we begin the Community Plan update program. These questions are meant to guide group conversations, for example in a meeting or on a community walking tour.

The questions below are separated by issue area. Wherever possible, please identify specific neighborhoods, corridors, blocks, uses, assets or parcels in your answers. Doing so will help Planning Department staff make targeted efforts in the Community Plan Update.

	supermarkets, big-box retail, shopping malls, etc. are appropriate?
Residential	- What aspects of your neighborhood would you like to see maintained?
Areas	- What are some changes happening in neighborhoods around you and how do you
	feel about them?
	- What do you think might enhance your neighborhood, that is, what's something
	lacking in your neighborhood that you'd like to see, or like to see more of?
Industrial	- Are there areas in the community where there are incompatibilities between
Areas	industrial uses and other types of uses?
Aicus	- Are there areas between industrial and other uses that need stricter regulations?
Open Space	- Is there enough open space in the community and if not, what kind of open space
& Public	is needed? (i.e., playing fields, neighborhood or pocket parks, bike paths, etc.)
