Project Description:

Dramatic chain is such a current style. Get a new take on 3 different stitches while learning to seed bead over small armatures. Rings have tons of uses like creating fashion forward earrings, dramatic bracelets or a variety of types of necklaces.

Skill level required: All skill levels and ages welcome. At least a little prior experience with off loom bead weaving is helpful.

Supplies (for bracelet)

- Fireline 6 or 8 lb. or preferred beading thread
- size 11 seed beads (at least 2 coordinating colors)
- size 15 seed beads (at least 1 color)
- fringe beads (at least 1 color)
- metal rings, chain or jump rings, 1 inch diameter (or 1 inch rings of seed bead)

Tools:

- Size 11 or 12 beading needles
- Scissors
- Beading mat
- Task lamp
- Beeswax or Microcrystalline wax (optional)
- Flat nose pliers or chain nose pliers
- Wire cutter or memory wire cutter, if needed to cut open jump rings

Time required for class: 3 – 4 hours

Students will complete one of each type of link in class.
