For immediate release, WASKESIU LAKE, SK – Little AL's Mini Golf at Waskesiu Lake is now open. The brand-new course reflects natural, historic and cultural themes plus iconic treasures in Waskesiu and Prince Albert National Park, including a 27' tall tipi plus numerous animals including a life-size brown bear, bull elk, bison, pelican, eagle and beaver. The Starter Shack is a replica of Grey Owl's cabin design. The grand opening celebration is set for July 14 at 10:30 a.m.

The community-funded project raised \$466,416.38. Construction began in fall 2017 and was completed June 30, 2018. Countless volunteer hours were donated for project planning, landscaping and construction. The project, supported by the [Waskesiu Recreation Association](#), [Waskesiu Foundation](#), [Waskesiu Community Council](#), [Waskesiu Chamber of Commerce](#), and [Parks Canada Agency](#) benefits the local community. A portion of revenues will be donated to the Waskesiu Foundation, with the balance used to fund improved recreational programs and facilities in Waskesiu.

Little AL's Mini Golf, named in honour of the lead donor the *Alan Vincent Hadley Logue Memorial Golf Tournament*, has local origins. Alan Vincent Hadley Logue was a natural athlete and loved activities and sports of every kind, including golf. Alan was well known for his love of people – sharing a laugh and bringing light to all those around him. He could be seen puttering around Waskesiu in his van nicknamed 'Little AL' seeking out new adventure at every corner.

Alan's journey of 22 years took an unexpected turn when he was diagnosed in May 2011 with leukemia. Alan's courage and optimism never left him as he faced treatment and hospitalization, though his time in this life came to an end on February 10, 2012.

In honour of Alan's incredible spirit, his love of all physical activity, and his passion for people, Little AL's Mini Golf will live on as a lasting legacy in the community for residents and visitors to enjoy for many years. Alan's parents, friends and family will be on hand to celebrate at the grand opening July 14 with a ribbon cutting, \$5 rounds all day and treats starting at 10:30 am. The course is located at the corner of Waskesiu Drive and Montreal Drive in Waskesiu.
