1910 - 1981

Archie D. McIntyre, age 71, of Elkton, passed away suddenly Monday, Sept. 14 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon following a short illness.

McIntyre, a farmer and former employee at Active Industries, Elkton, was born June 13, 1910 in Sheridan Township, son of the late Neil and Mary (McPhail) McIntyre.

He was united in marriage to Helen Keillor on Oct. 24, 1936 at Bad Axe. The couple lived in Grant Township for 32 years and the last 14 years in Elkton.
