Solemnity of the Ascension
Matthew 28:16-20

“Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations . . .”

After his resurrection Jesus revealed himself to his disciples who had been his most faithful followers to prepare them for the day when he would return to his Father and no longer be physically with them. Jesus knew it would take time for them to fully realize the meaning of all they had seen and heard; they would be uncertain and fearful about how to proceed without him to lead and teach them; they would have to choose whether or not to accept the task of carrying on his mission and teaching others his message by their words and actions. After they saw Jesus ascend to his Father they banded together in anxiety and uncertainty. We may be tempted to judge them harshly for their lack of faith and courage. But what would we have done? They believed in Jesus but they had witnessed many unusual and frightening things. They stayed together and resolved their doubts and conquered their fears. When we have doubts and fears do we stay together? Do we spend time in prayer to resolve our doubts and act with courage?

Listening Session with Bishop Medley

The Church is listening - and wants to hear from you. In 2018, the 15th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops will be held, featuring the theme: "Youth, faith and vocational discernment." The goal of the synod is to help young people on their journey into adulthood and to discern the plan that God has for their lives. Pope Francis has asked bishops around the world to gather input on this topic from the faithful in their diocese. The information gathered at the listening sessions will be compiled and submitted to Rome for consideration at the 2018 Synod. This is a unique opportunity to tell Bishop Medley - and ultimately Pope Francis - what you think the Church is doing well and what it could do better.
