How the Early Years Pupil Premium was spent

This funding went towards supporting development and removing barriers to learning in all areas of the EYFS and narrowing the gap between EYPP and non EYPP in attainment and progress.

Evaluation of Impact of Additional Funding

- Enabled all children to take full advantage of all areas of provision within nursery, ensuring full access to all learning and enrichment opportunities.
- Additional resources targeted at maths and communication and language have helped remove barriers to learning and supported the majority of children to make more than 3 steps of progress in these areas.
- Able to meet the specific needs of each child in terms of personal, social and emotional development. This has also been supported by Signs 4 resources. Where most of the children are working above age expectations in making relationships.
- Access to the arts/culture of the arts.
- Use of the theatre and other forms to broaden cultural experiences.
