Tasting Notes:

Citrus colour with gold hues
The nose is ample, round and rich with notes of dried fruits and grape eaux-de-vie.
Attack in mouth is balanced between sweetness and alcohol finishing on light candied fruits notes lightly oxydized. Harmonious and lasting palate.

Fresh and gourmet wine with a delicate structure, the Pineau des Charentes white pairs well with a plate of cheese (i.e. Gorgonzola, aged Cheddar) as well as an aperitif or after diner drink (to serve chilled)
