ATF Requests Funding for Pistol Brace Amnesty & Registration Program

AmmoLand News has uncovered information showing that the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) is planning to force gun owners to register firearms with pistol braces as a National Firearms Act (NFA) ATF Form 1 item.

The <u>document</u> was uncovered in a budget justification from the ATF to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). This form confirms the leaked information AmmoLand News has heard for months from our inside sources at the ATF.

Our ATF inside sources have told AmmoLand News that the ATF was planning for an amnesty period where gun owners would be able to register their braced pistols as short-barreled rifles (SBR) and that it is expected they will receive a free tax stamp. The ATF charges \$200 per SBR. Currently, there are at least four million braced pistols in the United States.

The ATF posted the proposed pistol brace rules to the Federal Register late last year for public comment. Over 250,000 comments were submitted, with most comments being against any new regulations. The gun community let their voices be heard, and the ATF ignored them.





September's Shooting Drill – Dot Assessment Drill


This drill was inspired by the Active Self Protection Extra YouTube video.

Neil Does The "Dot Assessment Madness"

Using the free targets at the range (Bore Rifle Target). The one with 12 bullseye on it. Take a pen label the top left as 1, the next to the right as 2, the last one on the top row as 3. Second row label them as 4, 5, 6. This is all we will use for now.

At 3 yards shoot the '1' target once. Transition to the '6' target and shoot is 6 times. Then the '2' target twice. The '5' target 5 times. The '3' target 3 times. Then finally the '4' target 4 times.

See how fast you can shoot this drill. A few months after practice do it again, see if you improved.

A Swiss-based international standards organization, bowing to a request from American antigun groups, has voted to establish a special category code for tracking gun and ammo sales handled via credit card processors.

The Geneva-based International Organization for Standardization approved the request for new four-digit merchant category codes, or MCCs, last week for firearm and ammunition sales and sellers.

"Banks should report dangerous warning signs to law enforcement when extremists are quickly building up massive stockpiles of guns, but that first requires ensuring gun store transactions have a unique identifier," said John Feinblatt, president of Everytown, in a statement issued by Warren's office.

Leaked Documents Show FBI's Definition of a Militia Violent Extremist is YOU! Ammoland Inc. Posted on September 15, 2022, by John Crump

WASHINGTON, D.C. -(Ammoland.com)- Leaked Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) documents provided to AmmoLand News and posted on lawyer Steven Stamboulieh's Twitter account show that the FBI considers most of the Second Amendment community to be possible Militia Violent Extremist (MVE).

The documents were sent to all ATF field offices to guide agents in identifying signs of what could be signs of MVE. These signs include the "Boogaloo" flag or terms like "Big Igloo." The term has proliferated gun culture and taken on a life of its own.

The FBI also views the Punisher Skull as a sign of extremism. The skull comes from the Punisher comic book which anti-hero Frank Castle takes his murderous revenge on the criminal underworld. The skull has been used in several movies and a successful Marvel series. It has also been used by SEAL Team 3 and multiple law enforcement organizations, including the Punishers Law Enforcement Motorcycle Club. The Punishers LEMC has numerous FBI Agents as members.

The FBI also claims that the historic Alamo flag is also a sign of violent extremism. The flag features a canon with the words "Come and Take It" printed below. The phrase comes from the last stand of the 300 Spartans against the Persian armies.


