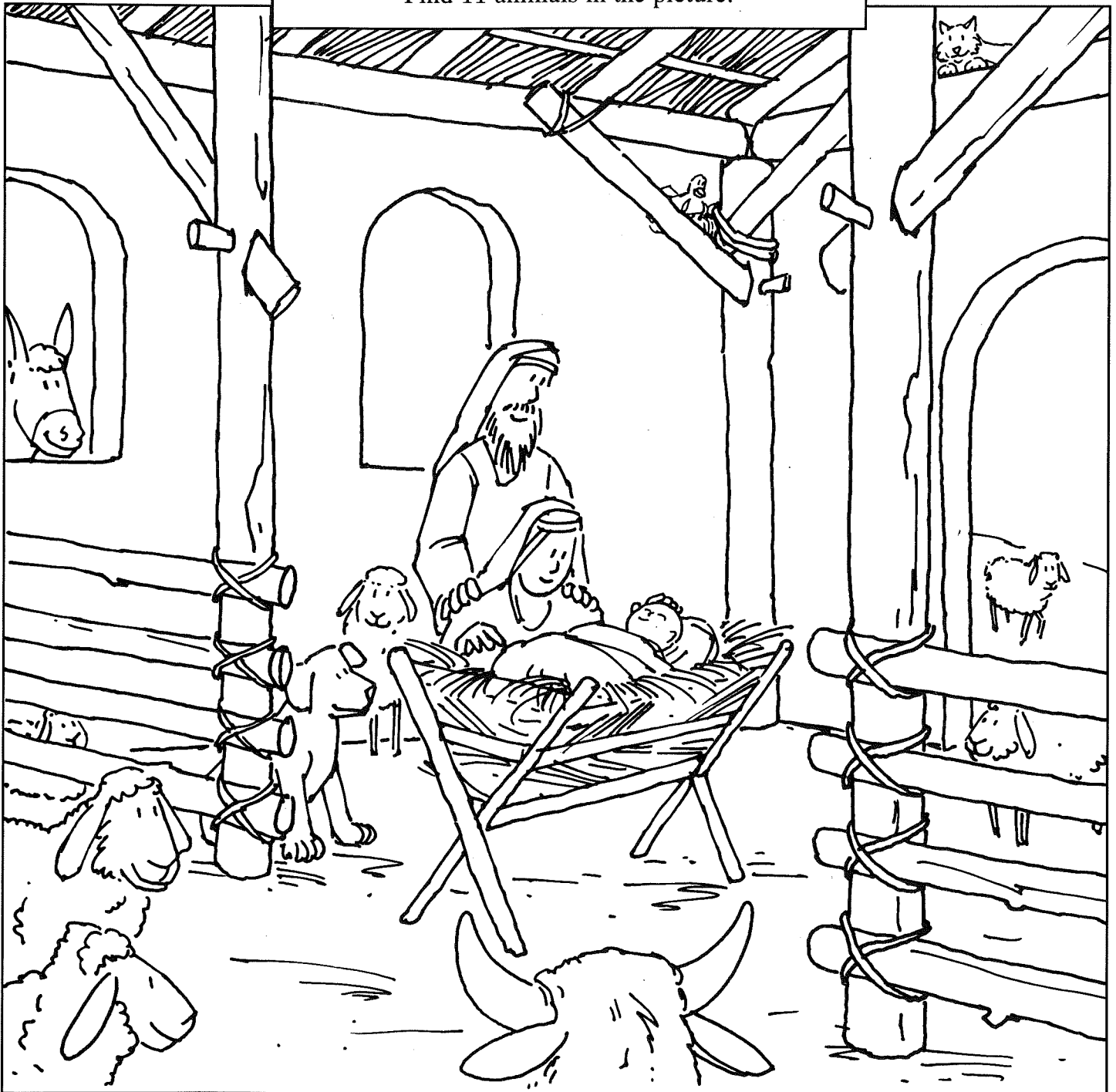


Mary and Joseph had to go to Bethlehem. There, Jesus was born in a stable.

Find 11 animals in the picture.

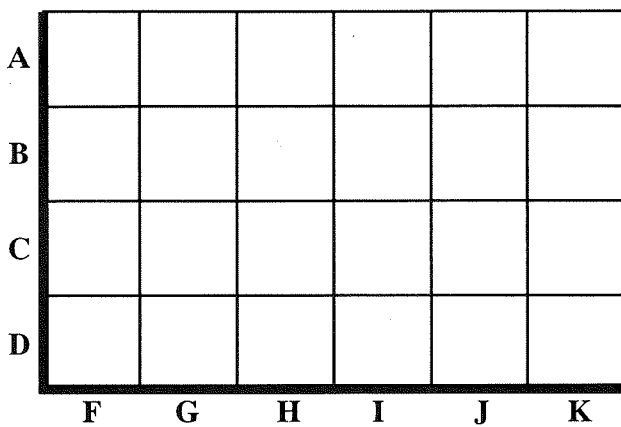
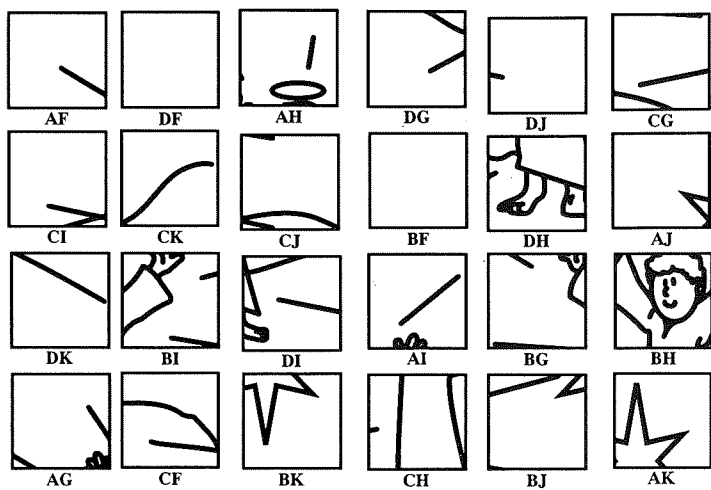

Copy the drawing into the correct squares.

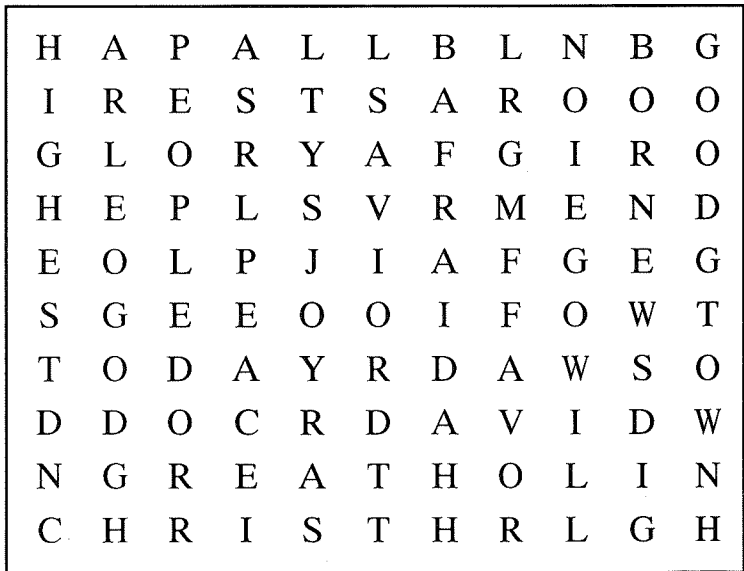
