

There will be tables in the Rock Room for you to display any items you wish to sell. You are responsible for monies collected and you must have everything removed by 9:00P.M. Saturday

If your registration fee does **not** accompany your registration form, you will **not** be considered registered. You **must** be registered in order to take classes. The Sunday Banquet is included in the registration fee.

The cost of each class consists of the following two (2) fees:

 (1) Class Fee: 4-hour class: \$12 members and non-members 6-hour class: \$18 members and non-members
 (2) Project Fee: Amount listed under class selected. This fee includes paint, surface picture, pattern and instructions. <u>This fee is paid directly to the teacher</u>. Make all checks payable to the teacher.

In selecting classes, use the following guidelines:

Beginner	Taught at a slow pace with teacher assistance.
Intermediate	Taught at a medium pace with moderate teacher assist.
Advanced	Taught at a brisk pace with minimal teacher assist.

Bring your normal painting supplies to class. This includes brushes, palette, paper towels, brush cleaner (odorless but baby oil preferred) two water containers, graphite paper (black & white), stylus, etc. If any special supplies are required, they will be listed in the class description.

The art of decorative painting uses products that may cause adverse reactions to those with sensitivity. You are asked to use your judgment as to classes that you attend. GTDP assumes no liability for these products. <u>Absolutely no sprays, odorless turp or products</u> <u>labeled "hazardous" may be used inside or near open doors or windows at Crestfield.</u>

Class Confirmations & Class Vouchers

Please include your email address for your confirmation, if available. They will only be mailed, if you included a self-addressed stamped envelope. Email is the preferred way as it is quicker. If you do not submit either you will receive your class vouchers at Retreat Registration.

Project Fees (payable to Teachers)

In each classroom, a monitor will take attendance and collect the envelopes containing the project fee to be paid directly to the teacher. Please prepare an envelope for each class. Enclosed in the envelope should be:

- (1) Class Voucher
- (2) Project Fee either check made payable to the Teacher or exact cash. The monitors do not have change.

You will not be able to take the class without a Class Voucher from either Registration or Class Sales.

Any class cancellation refunds will be given at the Registration Desk. Any Retreat Registration refunds must be requested by September 17th.






