
The annual Village tax bill was mailed the end of February. If you pay your taxes directly and have not received your tax bill, please contact the Village Office. To avoid interest penalties your **Village taxes must be paid no later than April 1, 2015.**

Just to remind you, Village Elections will be held on Tuesday, June 16, 2015 at the Keystone Yacht Club. To be eligible to vote in the Village election you must be registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections. Applications to register by mail are available at Village Hall and must be in the hands of the Board of Elections no later than June 5, 2015. If you expect to be away at the time of the election, you may obtain an application for an absentee ballot at Village Hall.

We request that you please remind your gardener that annual permits must be renewed at Village Hall for the 2015 season. Only gardeners holding valid permits will be permitted to work. These permits are routinely checked and help to ensure that work is being accomplished within the guidelines of the village code.
