

## **Course: Painting with a Purpose**

### **Required Materials**

- Plastic water container
- paper towels
- #4H, #4B pencils
- Small Sketchbook, 5x7
- kneaded eraser
- palette with mixing area and wells
- viewfinder for composition
- masking tape
- cut sponge
- photos of what inspires you
- Any landscape, nature or botanic photos you have taken

### **Brushes:**

- 1" flat watercolor brush
- #8 round Princeton (4050) brush

### **Papers:**

- 1 sheet of 22" x 30" 140 or 300 lb. Arches cold press watercolor paper or equivalent cut into pieces 11"x15"

1. Don't buy cheap paper
2. Cut the sheet of 22"x 30" Arches 300 lb. cold press paper into four 11"x 15" sheets.
3. You will need some type backing board (like gator board) to put the cut paper on.

**Paints:** Try to buy either Holbein or Windsor/Newton watercolors.

- cadmium yellow light hue
- viridian green
- cerulean blue
- alizarin crimson
- cobalt blue hue
- cadmium red light hue
- yellow ochre
- ultramarine blue (sometimes called French ultramarine)
- olive green

**Please feel free to bring any additional watercolor supplies or paint colors you like and may have acquired from previous watercolor classes and workshops.**
