

A message from Head teachers 25th June 2020

We have had a very successful and extremely smooth start to the wider reopening of school. We have welcomed back 32 Year 6 pupils and 30 Year 1s as well as over 40 keyworker children. It has been lovely to see so many smiling faces and it is clear that the children are happy to be back in school with their friends and teachers.

On Monday 29th June we are opening school to F2 and we will be starting the week with 32 more pupils. We have continued to follow the government social distancing guidance which recommends children should be 2m apart. In order to maintain this we can only fit between 8 and 10 pupils in each of our classrooms and this means that currently, we are unable to offer any more children time in school before the end of term. We will be arranging outdoor visits for children who will be starting in F1 and F2 at Hempshill Hall in September. Work will continue to be uploaded onto the class pages on the website. Please contact us via your class email if you wish to discuss anything with us.

The school will be closed for the summer break for all children. At present we do not know how the school will be operating in September and we are waiting for new government guidance. We very much hope to be opening our doors to everyone. Whenever the children return they will start the new school year in their old class. This will give them time to talk about their experiences and be in a familiar setting with their current teachers. During the first few days back in school all children will spend the morning in their new class and have an opportunity to ask questions and address any worries they may have.

We will be sending out your child's report on 10th July and this will have information about their new class. Please keep checking the school website for updates and information.
