

ArbiterPay

To transfer funds from your ArbiterPay account is very simple.

1. Go to ArbiterPay.com and sign in.
2. Select the Transfers Tab on the left.

From here you will have 3 options to send your funds:

- **To Bank Account** – This is a free option that may take 1-3 business days.

*At the bottom of this request form it will ask, “Would you like to skip this step in the future and have your funds automatically transferred to your bank account when they become available?” – If you choose yes there will be a \$1.50 fee per transaction.

- **To ArbiterPay Debit Card** - \$4.95 processing fee to mail you your debit card. Funds become automatically available when you transfer to ArbiterPay Debit Card.

IF – Insufficient Funds

*If you did not originally sign up for an ArbiterPay debit card and later decide you want one. Sign into ArbiterPay and on the right hand side of the default tab (Accounts) you will see Request Card in orange.

- **By Check** – Requesting a check to be sent to the address on your ArbiterPay profile will cost \$8.50 per check. This request takes 2-3 business days.

* You may request checks for each contest you officiate or you can let the funds build up all year and request one check for the whole season. How frequent you receive a check is left up to you.

FAQ's

Is my Arbiterpay account the same as my checking account?

No, think of your Arbiterpay account as a "holding" account for money you have earned as an official. To get that money, you have to transfer it, put it on your Arbiter Card or have it sent in a check.

Does it cost me anything?

Not if you choose to deposit money into your checking account.

How often do I get a check if I choose that option?

You can choose how often a check is cut to you.

Do I have to Sign up for Arbiterpay?

No you do not. However, if a school chooses to pay through Arbiterpay, that is the only way that you will get paid.

Will I get a 1099?

Yes Arbiter will send you a 1099 at the end of the year for all the games worked and paid through Arbiterpay
