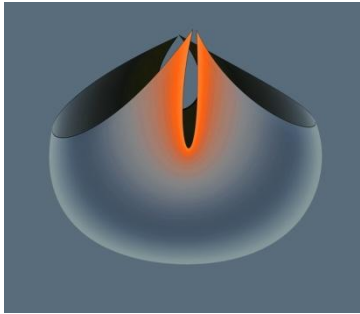

Please name image files with your name and the title (Your Name – Title of Image.jpg). Note the double spaces around the dash. Any extraneous information will become part of the title or author. Please also put the month in the subject of the email (Images for (Month)).

It was a great conference with 17 professional photographers teaching workshops, giving tips of the trade and speaking on various photography subjects. Sessions were held in Wildlife, Landscape, Portrait, Wedding, Baby, Macro and Post Processing. The overall theme was "Imagery to Artistry".

Camera Rochester had about 13 people in attendance who all had a great time soaking up knowledge and testing things they learned in the hands on workshops and field trips. We had several winners of Honorable Mention Ribbons for the Digital and Print Salons including Michelle Turner, Sheila Nelson, Tom Kredo, Dave Valvo, Paul Schwedfeger (2) and Luann Pero. The Golden Horseshoe competition was judged by three of the photographers at the conference on Friday night and we all got to see all the images. Camera Rochester came in 12th out of 14 clubs participating.

There was a special presentation to Dan Neuberger who won the NFRCC Lifetime Achievement Award. Congratulations to Dan! Thank you to Carl Crumley who put together an excellent video about Dan's photography and achievements. It was nice for everyone to see what Dan was being honored for. - Contact the Librarian via email with the title and author of the book and your full name and phone at: camera.rochester.librarian@gmail.com
- You will be contacted by the book's owner to set up a meeting to pick up the book. This is easiest done at a club meeting, where there is a red folder containing sign-out forms. 3 copies of the form are filled out, for the borrower, lender and librarian. You set a return date with the lender.
- The Librarian will send an email reminding you when the book is due for return.
- Contact the book's owner to arrange the return.

NEW: Competition Change

Starting with the March competition, members will be allowed to enter only three (3) images in competition instead of the usual four. Unchanged is that only two images may be entered in any one category. The Board is viewing this as an experiment to see if limiting the number of images will help meetings end earlier as has been a request of several members.

Barnes and Noble Show: Portfolio Guidelines

As you consider which images you will enter in the spring B+N show, be aware that the same challenge applies this year as last. The three images you enter must be a mini portfolio, a cohesive theme. The three images must be framed as follows:

1. Portfolios should be 3 separate pieces but with the same orientation.
2. They should have white, gray, or black mats
3. Only black frames should be used and frames must include wires attached, ready for hanging
4. Minimum size is 11 X 14 framed; maximum size is 24" framed.

Barnes and Noble Annual Show

You must submit a **three image portfolio**. The fee is \$25 for the entire portfolio. You may bring your entry form and check to the May club meeting or you can send a check made out to Camera Rochester to: Lisa Cook, 180 Canterbury Rd., Rochester NY 14607

Again this year, instead of printing costly post cards we will electronically send you a flyer. Please feel free to print it and distribute to friends and family so they will know when to visit the show.

We will need volunteers for a variety of tasks. Please consider how you might be able to help. We will pass a sign-up sheet at the club meetings leading up to the show. Areas where we'll need help are: registration, hanging the show, the reception, and taking down the show.

Show Details:

When: May 28 – June 25, 2016

Where: Barnes and Noble, Pittsford Plaza, Monroe Avenue, 2nd floor Community Room during store hours

Sales: All sales are handled by the photographer. Barnes and Noble does not permit the sale price of the image to be listed on the program or title card. A price list will be available at the Information Desk on the first floor.

Eligibility: You must be a current, paid up member of Camera Rochester.

Procedure: All images must be black or dark brown gallery appropriate framed and have a wire on the back for hanging.

Minimum framed size is 11X14; maximum size 24". Mats should be white, black or gray unless otherwise pre- approved by Lisa Cook, show chairperson.

Attach the entry tag (from next page) to the back upper left hand corner of each image.
