Greetings friends,

You ever fall down an information rabbit hole? I'm sure you have. We live in an information age and every year information seems to come faster and faster. Additionally, the collective research of the world is at our fingertips. You ever Google who won the Cy Young award in 1964 and only three clicks later you're somehow on the Wikipedia page for the George Forman grill? (This may have actually happened to me). You're looking for a recipe online and you realize you lost an hour looking up ten different dishes that caught your eye. You tried to take a quiz to tell you your Harry Potter house and now it's 1 AM and you're scrolling BuzzFeed.

It's dizzying the information we have access to, and in the social media age it's even becoming more rapidly digestible. We think of Instagram and TikTok as vanity tools for young people. Did you know people with doctorates in Near Eastern Culture, Hebrew, Greek, Biblical Studies, Jewish Studies, Classical Greek are using these platforms to create short and easily understood classes in the history and culture of the Bible? The ability to access some of the brightest minds in modern Christianity is literally in our hands.

This unprecedented access can also lead many of us to finding out one of the dirty little secrets of the church. Here it is...a lot of the things that we associate with Jesus or Scripture are actually man-made traditions or man-made ideas. I shared with the congregation that I fell down a research hole during Christmas as I started analyzing all the Christmas imagery that has no basis in historical fact or Scriptural testimony.

Everyone knows "God helps those who help themselves", right? But who came up with that idea (Hint: it wasn't Jesus)? I've heard preachers say: "If you had more faith, you wouldn't be depressed". Is that real? Is that in the Bible? I mean, God won't give you more than you can handle! (I'm pretty sure that's in there....or... is it?)

We could make a whole list of idioms that Christians believe that don't come from Scripture. So, let's take a look at the things that Jesus DIDN'T say so that we remember the importance of the things Jesus DID say.



Giving to your local church using Tithe.ly is super easy! We offer a number of different ways to give to your church, as listed below:

#1 - Give on your **Church Website**

The recommended way to give is to go through your church's website. They likely have a section titled "Giving" or "Online Giving" where you can give using the Tithe.ly platform. If they do not have that, you can use one of the methods listed below.

#2 - Give Online

If you're on a computer (or any device with an internet connection), you can easily give to your church by heading to Tithe.ly/Give. Once there, search for your church, and fill in the giving form.

#3 - Give in App

Want to give to your church using the convenience of your smartphone? No problem! Download the Tithe.ly App from the <u>App Store</u> (iPhone) or Google Play Store (Android). Once you've downloaded the app, create an account or log in, locate your church and tap "Give Now" to complete your gift!
