

Box Cushion

Required items:

- Notepaper/pen
- Enough fabric of an appropriate weight to cut tops, bottoms and side walls to your planned cushion with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowances (dimension + 1")
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of similar or slightly lighter weight fabric to make the piping (same fabric ok) You'll need more if you're making an extra-large project.
- A zipper at least 4 inches longer than the dimension that will be the "back" of your cushion (They're hard to find in town in colors other than black or white. If you'd like me to order one in, get in touch with the color and dimension, and I'll have it there for you by the 2nd day of class.)
- Matching thread

Provided Items:

- ✓ Up to 8 yds. of narrow or medium welting

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Large, sturdy, quilting ruler (approx 6"x 24" and made of hard plastic)
- Scissors and/or rotary cutter
- Sturdy pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Tape Measure
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Supply bin/tote
- Hem gauge
- Sewing machine and/or serger
