Divine Mercy Sunday

In 1931 Sr. Faustina, now St. Faustina, received a vision of an image of the Lord Jesus. He asked her to paint the image according to what she saw, and to sign it 'Jesus, I trust in you' as a reminder of God's love and mercy. The painting was completed in 1934.

Victims of WWII were among the first

to be comforted by this image. Jesus told Faustina he wanted the image public venerated on the first Sunday after Easter. St. Pope John Paul the II declared the second Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday, and this was celebrated for the first time in 2002 by the Universal Church.

Today you can pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet as a family. Prayer cards are available by the church doors. You could even make today fun and create a Divine Mercy 'Sundae' – top your ice cream with a cherry to represent the heart, and lines of whip cream with red and blue sprinkles to represent the rays. Blue represents the water that makes souls righteous, while the red represents the blood that gives souls life.

Burmese Community Vaccine Clinic

After the Sunday Masses today, April 18th, and April 25th volunteers and translators will be available to assist any Burmese person aged 18 or older fill out forms to receive the COVID-19 Vaccination. We will have a clinic on May 1st here in the parish hall to administer the first dose for our Burmese Community. When you receive your form you will sign up for a time to arrive to receive your 1st dose. We will have a second clinic near the end of May to administer the 2nd dose. Anyone who would like to help coordinate and assist with this event please contact Sara Lewis at the church office.

Families in Faith

Today was the final preparation lesson for our first Communion class! Today their lesson was on *journeying*. They learned about the journey we're on toward heaven, and how the Eucharist stays with us after we received it. The children will be preparing for their First Communion on May 1st in the coming weeks. Pray for them as they pray and reflect, especially on the 24th of April as they participate in a retreat. Welcome them to the Eucharistic feast on May 2nd and the 11:00 AM mass!


