Why not used socks?

Most shelters treat socks as undergarments and cannot accept previously worn socks, even those in good condition.

What type of socks are best?

There is a greater need for men's black crew socks, but any NEW socks for men, women, or children are greatly appreciated,

Health issues

The homeless suffer many health issues related to a lack of socks (or old, damp socks), including frostbite, infections, nerve damage and ulcerations. According to The Hoboken Shelter in New Jersey, some of their visitors walk over 10 miles per day.
