## MASS READING RELFECTION

August 16, 2020

1st Reading Kgs 56:1,6,7

[ Justice and Salvation for All]

After the Hebrews returned from exile in Babylon, they found many foreigners not of the Jewish religion living there. The anonymous prophet called Third Isaiah had to face this changed situation. Ezekiel, "the father of Judaism," was bposed to uncircumcised foreigners in the temple precincts.

The composer of this poem is not so rigorous. He lists the conditions under which non-Jews may worship in the temple. "Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be acceptable on my [God] altar." This passage has been chosen to introduce the idea of universalism found in today's Gospel reading. "May the people praise you, O God; may all the people praise you! (Responsorial Psalm).

2nd Reading Rom 11:13-15, 29,32

[Irrevocable Gifts and Call]

We must interpret this reading in the light of Paul's misconception that the end, that is, the second coming of Christ; hence, Paul turns to the Gentiles (non-Jews). This will provoke Israel's jealousy and they will join before the end! Matthew, who wrote some thirty years later, had to make a slight adjustment in Paul's vision of Salvation History. This adjust-ment should not shock us, The Bible itself suggests that the understanding of Salvation History should be adjusted constantly in the light of changing circumstances.

In dealing with the Jews and their religion, we should keep in mind Paul's state-ment: "The gift and the call of God are irrevocable." Anti-Semitism is wrong. Israel's place in Salvation History is God concern , not ours. The Jews deserve our love, respect, and gratitude! Christ, Mary, Joseph, and the apostles were all Jews and Old Testament is the Hebrew Bible.

Let us humbly admit it. If a certain kind of triumphalism would have been confined to "Jesus Christ and his abundant love for us is unsurpassed," it would have been all right. But often the beauty, truth, and riches of the Catholic Faith were identified with its proud sharers, and resulted in that ominous "we are right and you are wrong" complex that has caused so much damaging alienation.

It is the great merit of Pope John XXIII that he "opened the windows" and all the Second Vatican Council that it strove to do away with all "ghetto mentality." Belonging to God's chosen people does not mean that we are necessarily better than people who following their own conscience seek God in a different way.

Today's Bible reading suggest an openness in love and respect for others, as taught in the contemporary setting by the Council's Decree on Ecumenism.
