Report any injuries to a coach immediately.  
Be prepared to sub for an injured teammate.  
After last event, everyone runs 4 x 50/100.

All tickets must be purchased ahead of time at HomeTown Ticketing | Search or on the Hometown app (White and Grey app with a Capital H on the app). You may purchase tickets online at the gate. No cash will be accepted at the gate.

- a. Open App
  - b. Search for Milwaukee Lutheran High School
  - c. Click on event you would like to purchase tickets.
  - d. Click on Red bar at the bottom "Buy Tickets."
  - e. Edit the number of tickets you would like to purchase using the + or - button.
  - f. Click on Checkout (please note that if this is the first-time using Ticket Spicket, you will need to register for a new account.)
  - g. Confirm the total is correct, the system will ask you to select Checkout again.
  - h. After you pay for your tickets, find the option on the top of your screen labeled MY TICKETS. Otherwise you can click the blue button that is labeled VIEW MY TICKETS AND PASSES.
  - i. Click on the ticket you purchased.
  - j. Click on VIEW TICKETS then the ticket itself. When the gate is open, you will be able to click on a green button that is labeled CHECK-IN OR REDEEM TICKET.
2. Ticket sales will open on Monday, May 13 at 9:00am and close at 6:00pm on Thursday, May 16.
  3. Tickets may not be printed at home. They need to be scanned at the event and shown in the Hometown app on cellular devices to be scanned. NO SCREENSHOTS ACCEPTED.
  4. Gates/entrance open 2:30pm scheduled start time of the Field Events. Gates/entrance will lock at 6:00pm. Anyone not in the meet at this time will not be allowed in.
  5. Refunds will only be issued for ticket purchases if the event is canceled.
  6. No re-entry to the event, once you leave you will not be allowed to go back in.
  7. All middle/elementary school students must be with an adult.
