NELSON BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION

SIKKEMA RETURNS TO GISBT WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 2nd TIME

SIKKEMA'S MATCH PLAY PERFORMANCE SECURES 2nd TOUR CROWN

Seth Sikkema parlayed a perfect 8-0 match play record into the 2nd tour title of his career at this month's event. The powerful 2-hander from Fulton, Illinois claimed the #5 seed heading into the finals, although just 72 pins separated all 8 finalists heading into the head-to-head competition. Sikkema grabbed the lead after the 2nd game of match play, and kept rattling off win after win, eventually disposing of each opponent and recording 8 wins to pull away from his rivals, with his final victory margin being 177 pins. He maintained his perfect record by tossing a 10th frame strike in the position round to top runner-up Alex Diercks 190-189.

Sikkema prevailed on one of the most demanding lane patterns the tour has ever seen. Just 6 players qualified with a score of plus, and the cut to match play fell at -23, while the cash number was -68. At the end of 16 games, just 4 players had averaged 200 for their 16 games.

The champion collected a \$350 payday, as well as the championship plaque. It was the 11th match play finals appearance of his successful career. For his 16 games, he averaged 207.43 on the challenging conditions. Congratulations, Seth!

DIERCKS IN CAREER FORM, NABS RUNNER-UP FINISH

Alex Diercks enjoyed one of his finest days on the lanes, rolling his way to the highest GISBT finish of his career – a runner-up showing. Diercks, from Cedar Rapids, Iowa, was appearing in the 3rd match play finals of his career. The right-hander staged an impressive rally late in his qualifying round to secure a spot in the finals. His 16-game total was just 27 pins behind the champion, but the difference came in match play, as his 3-5 match play record fell short of Sikkema's perfect 8-0 ledger. Despite being 3-5, Diercks averaged an impressive 210 in match play, and rolled just 1 game under 190 during the finals. He collected a \$225 payday for his day's work.

85 PLAYERS COMPETE IN WATERLOO

This month's starting field was comprised of 85 players (59 boys and 26 girls). This included 15 bowlers making their GISBT debut! Welcome to all of our new and returning players!

WOLF EARNS BEST CAREER FINISH BY TAKING 3rd

Avery Wolf returned to the finals for the first time since a 4th place showing at last season's February event in Moline, Illinois. This time out, the smooth stroking southpaw finished one spot higher – in 3rd place – and it earned the Skokie, Illinois native a \$200 scholarship. He was one of only 4 players on the boy's side to average 200 for the day.

PAST CHAMP SOLONKA STAKES 4th

Dakota Solonka continued his great start to the 2019-2020 campaign this month. The 2-hander from Indianapolis finished runner-up at last month's season opener in Cedar Rapids, and this month he was in contention again, eventually settling for 4th place. The 20 year-old was making his 5th GISBT match play finals, and his performance earned him a \$175 scholarship.

REID, IN 2nd STRAIGHT FINALS, FINISHES 5th

Clayton Reid has competed in a pair of GISBT events, and has a pair of top 5 finishes to show for his efforts. At last month's season opener, the right-hander from Bismark, North Dakota finished 4th; this month, he bettered that by securing a 4th place finish that netted him a \$150 payday. Reid sports a lot of potential, and is definitely a versatile player that bears watching in future events.

MINER TAKES 6th

Jayson Miner was this month's 6th place finisher. The lanky right-hander from Silvis, Illinois was appearing in the 6th match play finals of his career, and he took home a \$125 scholarship by virtue of his performance.

QUALIFYING LEADER MILLER FINISHES 7th

Evan Miller returned to the finals for the 2nd straight month; this time out, the big-hooking right-hander finished in 7th place. The Sioux Falls, South Dakota native led the field at +49, but he struggled during match play,, sliding into 7th place. Miller, one of 3 past champions in this month's boy's finals field, hauled in a \$110 scholarship for his day's work.

GRUBAUGH 8th IN MATCH PLAY DEBUT

Donovan Grubagh rounded out this month's match play field by finishing 8th. The right-hander from Salem, Oregon was appearing in just his 3rd GISBT event, with a 19th place finish being his previous best showing; that came at last season's September event in Cedar Rapids. This time out, he took home a \$100 scholarship for his day's work.

This month's high game out of the money was awarded to Nick Fox, of Elmwood Park, Illinois. He began his qualifying round with a 254, and that was enough to earn him a \$55 scholarship.

NELSON BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION POSTS DOMINANT VICTORY IN WATERLOO

Addy Nelson put on one of the most dominant displays in recent tour history at this month's event. On a demanding tournament lane pattern, the talented right-hander from Gregory, South Dakota was the only competitor in the girl's division to average 200 during qualifying, coming in with an 8-game block of exactly 1600, and that enabled her to carry a 107-pin lead into the match play finals.

Nelson continued her great bowling during the finals by averaging 214.16, with all 6 games over 200. She was simply unstoppable, winning all 6 matches, and eventually pulling away to an impressive 312 pin margin of victory.

NELSON BECOMES TOUR'S 85th DIFFERENT GIRLS CHAMPION

She became the tour's second straight first-time champion, following in the footsteps of Sydney Urben, who won the season opening tour stop in Cedar Rapids. The GISBT began in August 1992, and this month Nelson became the tour's 85th female champion.

For her 14 games, the champion averaged 206.07. She took home the \$275 winner's prize, the championship plaque, and a permanent place on Champion's Row. Congratulations, Addy!

COUREY CLAIMS RUNNER-UP FINISH

3-time tour winner Cassidy Courey earned this month's runner-up finish, as well as the accompanying \$200 payday. One of the tour's top stars over the past several seasons, the Brooklyn Center, Minnesota native was appearing in the 18th match finals of her career.

PALMER ROLLS INTO 25th MATCH PLAY FINALS, PLACES 3rd

Bailey Palmer, a 4-time GISBT champion, was this month's 3rd place finisher. The Ottumwa, Iowa resident earned a \$150 award for her performance. Bailey's match play appearance was the 25th of her stellar tour career.

SWANK FINISHES 4th

Christin Swank was this month's 4th place finisher. The right-hander from Muscatine, Iowa staged a heroic finish during qualifying just to reach the finals – the 18th of her illustrious career. She earned a \$125 scholarship for her performance.

MOORE PLACES 5th

Rachel Moore is off to a great start to the 2019-2020 campaign. The 14 year-old grabbed runner-up honors at last month's season opener, and this month, backed up that solid performance with another finals appearance. This time, the Keokuk, Iowa resident took home a \$110 by finishing 5th; it marked Moore's 3rd match play finals appearance.

LAKE FINISHES 6th IN TOUR DEBUT

Alexis Lake made her GISBT debut a memorable one by qualifying for the match play finals, where she finished in 6th place. The promising right-hander from Kaysville, Utah was rewarded with a \$100 scholarship for her high finish.

Kayla Gifford, from Camanche, Iowa, took home a \$55 scholarship for her 245, which was this month's highest game out of the money.
