

Partners in Pilot

New Jersey Lions (MD16)

Participating Clubs qualify applicants, provide a volunteer optometrist or use a Vision USA provider for the exam. The Club will be asked to donate at a reduced cost for eyewear. No Club will be denied if they do not to make a donation to help sustain the program.

Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF)

LCIF created the Lions Lens to reduce cost of eyewear. LCIF has partnered with Essilor in the CURE Program, in part, to provide low cost lenses for Lions Refractive Error Programs.

Essilor

Essilor works with LCIF to support NJLERC and other pilots by providing low cost lenses and reduced costs for edging through the Essilor Lab in Warren, NJ and Nassau Lens.

Optometry Cares (AOA Foundation)

Commonly referred to as Vision USA

Provide access on pilot basis to AOA member optometrists who volunteer to provide a specific number of free eye exams for Lions Club Referrals made through NJ CURE Program.

Will publicize CURE and solicit additional Vision USA volunteers.
