

Bylaw 11-2106

A Bylaw to Provide for Penalties for Contravention of Bylaws

The Council of the Resort Village of Big Shell, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw” of the municipality.
2. Sections 3 and 4 apply to an infraction of the bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of the Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 or not less than \$200.00 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of the Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or not less than \$200.00 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaws 1-83 and 1/04 are hereby repealed.
