## Bylaw 11-2106

## A Bylaw to Provide for Penalties for Contravention of Bylaws

The Council of the Resort Village of Big Shell, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Sections 3 and 4 apply to an infraction of the bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of the Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more the \$2,000.00 or not less than \$200.00 and costs for every offence.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of the Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more the \$5,000.00 or not less than \$200.00 and costs for every offence.
- 5. Bylaws 1-83 and 1/04 are hereby repealed.
