FROM THE PASTOR

We are now in the season of Lent. I always chuckle when folks ask about what the heck a season of "lint" means. Lent is an unfamiliar word to many. "Lent" comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *lencten* which means "spring." It is a time when the days 'lengthen', often to our delight.

The season is a span of forty days, not counting Sundays, beginning on ASH WEDNESDAY (this year February 26) and it ends on the day before Easter Sunday. It is often a time of preparation, of introspection. The season calls us to look for the path to new life, a new season of life.

If you are so inclined, I have a suggestion for you to inspire your season of Lent. "Saving Grace" is a wonderful movie to bring some insight to these days of Spring. Tom Conti stars as a youthful Pope in this movie. It is a combination of finding new life, building community with a flair for comedic moments.

During an audience he meets a young impoverished girl from Montepetra whose village has no priest. Sometime later, the Pope dons his gardening clothes and goes into the yard of the Vatican residence, tending his beloved plants. His list for planting is caught by the wind and carried up over the brick wall and outside the Vatican garden. The Pope pushes open the wall door and steps outside to retrieve his wayward list. The door closes behind him and he realizes that he is locked out. He tries to get back in and cannot. He then sees a chance to be out in the world and off he goes. He decides on a journey to Montepetra.

The Pope gains a whole new sense of identity, community and love. It is a saving grace indeed.

May the saving grace of this season of new life fill your heart with restoration and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Sunday, April 5 following worship






Women's Fellowship
